ABOUT LAST NIGHT: The Doubledays scored for in the second, four in the fourth and sixth in the fifth to take a commanding 14-2 lead and never looked back...RHP Brandon Welch allowed eight runs on six hits in 2.0 innings of relief...Starter RHP Octavio Acasta didn't fare much better, allowing six runs, four earned, on five hits over 3.0 innings...Brooklyn went 1-for-15 with RISP and left 10 men on base.

VS. AUBURN: The Cyclones are 24-19 all-time against the Auburn Doubledays, including 1-2 against the D-Days in 2013...The team's last met in Brooklyn in 2012 with the Cyclones sweeping the three game series.

CURRENT 'CLONES: The Cyclones are 9-4 since July 19th, the date that OF Michael Conforto made his pro debut...Over these 13 games, the Cyclones are batting .287 (128-446) with 72 runs scored (5.5 per game)... Prior to this stretch, the team was batting .230 (255-1108) and averaging 3.4 runs per game.

MOORE OF THAT: Cyclones C/2B Tyler Moore has hit safely in six straight games, a season-high, with four multi-hit contests over this span...The former LSU Tiger had only one multi-hit game over his previous 35 appearances...Moore is batting .500 (11-22) over this stretch after starting July batting just .121 (7-58) in 20 games.

INJURY UPDATE: Cyclones 1B Michael Katz saw the doctors at the Hospital for Special Surgery on Thursday... It was determined that Michael should need surgery to repair the medial patelofemoral ligament and will miss the remainder of the 2014 season...Katz appeared in 42 games and hit .275 (42-153) with nine doubles, and 18 RBI for the Cyclones.

DOUBLE TROUBLE: Prior to this season, the Cyclones had not allowed double digit runs since August 26, 2012, now they have allowed 10 ore more runs on four occasions this season...Since the start of the 2010 season, the Cyclones have allowed double digit runs only six times.

SWEET SIX-CESS: The Cyclones have scored six runs or more in nine of their last 15 games after having scored six times on only five occassions during the team's first 32 games of the season.

UR NOT SO HOT: After hitting in 13-straight games for the Cyclones from July 14th-27th, 3B **Jhoan Ureña** is 3-for-23 over his last four games.

RISP-ECT: The Cyclones were 2-for-15 with Runners in Scoring Position during last night's game...Over their previous five games, the Cyclones hit .344 (22-64) with runners in scoring position...For the season, the team is batting .237 (103-435) with RISP.

PUT IT IN PLAY: RF Michael Bernal has hit safely in five straight games, his longest hitting streak of the year...He is hitting .455 (10-22) over this span...For the season, he is batting .435 (40-92) when he puts the ball in play...Bernal leads the NYPL with 65 strikeouts in 46 games, including 20 games with multiple strikeouts.

COMING & GOING: RHP Octavio Acosta was transferred to Savannah (A) of the South Atlantic League after last night's game...C Luis Arrizurieta was transferred to Kingsport (R) of the Appalachian League, but remains in Las Vegas (AAA)...OF John Mora joins the Cyclones from the GCL Mets where he was hitting .318 (35-110) with 29 runs scored, nine extra base hits, and 14 stolen bases.
