VS. LOWELL: The Cyclones are 42-27 against Lowell. including 3-0 this year...Brooklyn outscored Lowell 21-9 in their series in Massachusetts earlier this year...Brooklyn took two of three from Lowell at MCU Park last year.

**DOUBLEHEADERS:** The Cyclones are 2-2 in doubleheaders this season, splitting both twin bills with Staten Island and Hudson Valley...The Spinners are 2-0 in double dips... Brooklyn is 40-34 all-time in doubleheaders.

IROÑ MAÑ: Cyclones 3B Jhoan Ureña is the only player in the New York-Penn League to participate in all 57 games this season...The franchise record for most games in a single season is 74, set by OF Kirk Niewenhuis (2008), OF Caleb Stewart (2003) and 1B Ian Bladeraroen (2005).

GAME TWO STARTER: RHP Martires Arias was named the NYPL Pitcher of the Week for the period of August 4th-11th...The tall righthander tossed 6.0 shutout grames with six strikeouts in his Cyclones debut on Auaust 7th...He is the the 23rd Cyclones pitcher all-time to be tagged Pitcher of the Week...The righthander has not allowed a run over his last 22.0 innings on the mound.

MORA THAT: Cyclones CF John Mora has hit safely in seven of his nine games with an at-bat, including four multi-hit games...The lefty hitting outfielder is batting .367 (11-30) against righthanded pitching and .125 (1-8) against southpaws.

ABOUT LAST NIGHT: The Cyclones and Spinners were LOOKING ROSEY: SS Amed Rosario has hit safely in 19 of his last 24 games dating to July 16th...The 18-yearold, who is the fourth voungest player in the NYPL, is batting .305 (32-105) over this span and ranks second in the league with 32 hits over this span...He has raised his batting average from .260 to .282 during the course of this streak....For the season, Rosario is second in the NYPL with 59 hits, and is tied for the league lead with five triples.

> GET AHEAD, STAY AHEAD: The Cyclones are 21-6 (.778) when they score the first run of the game.

> **LEAVING THE YARD:** Brooklyn pitchers have allowed a league-low 16 home runs in 504.1 IP this season...Brooklyn has allowed just one home run in 10 games during the month of August...Similarly, Brooklyn batters have a leggue-low 17 home runs...They are tied with Mahonina Valley, and Connecticut with 17 home runs.

> UR-GOING STREAKING: Cyclones 3B Jhoan Ureña has hit safely in each of his last seven games, and is batting .367 (11-30) over these games...The 19-yearold already has a pair of 13-game hitting streaks this season and is only the second player in franchise history to have multiple hit streaks of 10 or more games in a single season.

> INJURY NEWS: Cyclones INF Will Fulmer is currently dealing with a left knee issue and is unavailable... INF **Dimas Ponce** has a lower abdominal injury and is also unavailable... OF Joe Tuschak is inching closer towards a return from a left hamstring injury...OF Michael Katz is expected to have surgery on his injured knee next week and will miss the remainder of the year.
