ABOUT LAST NIGHT: The Cyclones took an early 5-0 THE MENDOZA LINE: After last night's game, seven lead but watched it slip away as they lost their seventh straight, falling to Jamestown 8-6 in extra innings....SS Amed Rosario went 4-for-5 in a losing effort to pace the Brooklyn offense.

VS. JAMESTOWN: The Cyclones are 22-19 all-time against the Jammers...Brooklyn went 2-1 against Jamestown in 2013...The Cyclones and Jammers met in the first game in franchise history on June 19, 2001.

RECENT CYCLONES: After starting the season 11-4, the team has gone 4-14 since June 28th and have been outscored 91-55 in these games.

L.O.L - LOTS OF LOSSES: The Cyclones currently have a seven game losing streak, tied for the second longest in franchise history...Brooklyn lost seven straight in 2006 (8/13 - 8/22) and a franchise-worst nine games in 2002 (8/26 - 9/02).

JUST KEEP K'ING: Cyclones batters are currently leading the NYPL with 305 strikeouts this season in 1051 team at-bats (29.1 %)...The Cyclones have 14 games this season with 10 or more strikeouts...OF Michael Bernal leads the league with 48 k's, OF Michael Katz is tied for seventh (32), OF Joe Tuschak is tied for 10th (31) and 1B Jeff Diehl (30) is tied for 12th.

THE FROST OF JULY: The Cyclones are 4-12 during the month of July and have been outscored 75-46 in the 16 games...Brooklyn has scored three runs or less in 11 of 16 contests during the month...Cyclones pitchers have allowed 133 base hits in 130.2 innings during the month. as well as 48 base-on-balls.

of the 14 position players on the Brooklyn Cyclones roster are hitting below .200...Among qualifying batters, (players who have appeared in at least 19 games) five of the 15 lowest batting averages in the NYPL are on the Cyclones roster.

LOOKING ROSEY: SS **Amed Rosario**, who is currently the fourth youngest player in the NYPL, had a career-high four hits in last night's game...The shortstop had two doubles on the evening after not haveing an extra base hit since June 27th, a span of 15 games with an at-bat.

STARTING TO PURR: OF Michal Katz is batting .359 (14-39) over his last 11 games...The Mets 9th round selection in the 2014 MLB Draft has five multi-hit games in these 11 starts.

TOP HEAVY: Last night, eight of the team's 10 hits came from the top three batters in the lineup, the rest of the team went 2-for-24.

MICHAEL CONFORTO: Cyclones OF Michael Conforto will return to New York this evening after attending the Golden Spikes Awards in Los Angeles yesterday...The Mets 1st round pick in the 2014 MLB Draft is expected to be in the lineup for the first time tomorrow.

DEEP FREEZE: Cyclones OF **Tucker Tharp** is hitless in his last 11 at-bats and is hitting .107 (3-28) since July 8th...C Tyler Moore is 1-for-16 over his last five games and is batting just .119 (5-for-42) during July.

TO ERR IS HUMAN: After last night, the Cyclones now have 43 errors, 10th most in the NYPL.


