

ABOUT LAST NIGHT: The Jamestown Jammers completed a sweep of the Cyclones with a 12-7 win in 15 innings...The five hour and four minute marathon came to an end when the Jammers scored five runs in the top of the 15th after both teams were scoreless after the 9th.

against the Crosscutters...Brooklyn went 1-2 in Williamsport last season with the Cyclones taking two-of-three when the teams last met in Brooklyn during the 2012 season.

**RECENT CYCLONES:** After starting the season 11-4, the team has gone 4-15 since June 28th and have been outscored 103-62 in these games.

L.O.L - LOTS OF LOSSES: The Cyclones currently have an eight game losing streak, the second longest in franchise history...Brooklyn lost a franchise-worst nine games DEEP FREEZE: Cyclones OF Tucker Tharp is hitless in in 2002 (8/26 - 9/02).

JUST KEEP K'ING: Cyclones batters are currently leading the NYPL with 318 strikeouts this season in 1.108 team at-bats (28.7 %)...The Cyclones have 15 games this season with 10 or more strikeouts, including last night's 13 strikeout performance...OF Michael Bernal leads the league with 50 k's, OF Michael Katz is tied for sixth (35), and OF Joe Tuschak is ninth (33).

THE FROST OF JULY: The Cyclones are 4-13 during the month of July and have been outscored 87-53 in the 17 games...Brooklyn has scored three runs or less in 11 of 16 contests during the month...Cyclones pitchers have allowed 145 base hits in 145.2 innings during the month. as well as 55 base-on-balls.

MICHAEL CONFORTO: Cyclones OF Michael Conforto will make his professional debut this evening...He is expected to be the designated hitter...He last played in a game 48 days ago when Oregon State was eliminated from the post season following a 4-2 loss to UC-Irvine.

VS. WILLIAMSPORT: The Cyclones are 37-27 all-time TOP SHELF: OF Michael Conorto, selected 10th overall in the 2014 MLB Draft, is the highest drafted player to suit up for Brooklyn in franchise history...Previously, SS Gavin Cecchini (12th overall in 2012) held the mark...He becomes the eight first round pick to play for the team since 2001.

> THE 500 CLUB: The Cyclones are currently four games under .500...The team has never been more than seven games under .500 (0-7, in 2006)...Brooklyn is one of four pro franchises to finish .500 or better ever year since '01.

> his last 14 at-bats and is hitting .096 (3-31) since July 8th...C Tyler Moore is 1-for-20 over his last six games and is batting just .109 (5-for-46) during July.

> TO ERR IS HUMAN: After last night, the Cyclones now have 48 errors, 11th most in the NYPL...As a team, their .963 fielding percentage ranks just .001 ahead of Vermont and Batavia who are worst in the NYPL...The five errors committed by the Cyclones last night tied the franchise high, set for the third time this season, after having not occured since August 10, 2010 at Connecticut.

> AWESOME ACOSTA: Cyclones RHP Octavio Acosta currently ranks seventh in the NYPL in ERA (1.86), second in WHIP (0.72), fourth in opponents batting (.146), and leads the league with only 6.83 base runners/9 IP.
