ABOUT LAST NIGHT: For the second straight night SHINING STARS: RHP Gaby Almonte, RHP Alex the Cyclones managed only four hits, this time losing 2-1 to the Vermont Lake Monsters at Centennial Field... Brooklyn lost its third straight game, wasting a strong start from RHP Andrew Church (1-3) who allowed just two runs over 6.1 innings...C Jose Garcia went 1-for-2 and his fifth inning RBI single accounted for the lone run.

VS. VERMONT: The Cyclones are 53-24 all-time against the Vermont Lake Monsters, including 15-4 over the previous three seasons...Brooklyn won the season series 5-1 in 2012, 2013 & 2014...The Cyclones went 2-1 in the matchup at MCU Park earlier this season.

RECENT CYCLONES: Since July 20th, Brooklyn has aone 5-11, and scored three runs or less in 13 of 16 contests...The Cyclones have scored two runs in their last 29.0 innings dating to the 8th inning on August 3rd.

THE TRAGIC NUMBER: Since July 12th, if the Cyclones allow more than one run, the team is 3-15...Brooklyn is 8-16 overall during this stretch.

THE MAGIC NUMBER: The Cyclones are 14-2 when they score four or more runs in a game this season... Brooklyn has scored two runs or less 18 times this season and are 7-11 in these games...Brooklyn has scored one run or less on nine occassions, including last night.

NO HIT WONDERS: The Cyclones are currently last in the NYPL with a .218 team average, Aberdeen ranks 13th in the league at .232...Brooklyn ranks 158th out of 160 MiLB teams in batting, ahead of only the GCL Rays (.203) and GCL Astros (.196)...Among players with at least 83 atbats, the Cyclones have three players hitting under .200, with only one other NYPL player matching this criteria.

Palsha and 2B Vinny Siena, have been named to the 2015 NYPL All-Star Team...The three Cyclones will participate in the game at Ripken Stadium on Tuesday, August 18th...Three All-Stars is tied for the fewest in franchise history (2005 & 2008).

NOT SO GREAT IN MONTH #8: Since the calendar turned to August, Brooklyn has gone 1-5 and been outscored 36-12...The team is batting .210 (39-186) and the team ERA is 4.76 (27 ER / 51.0 IP).

NICKEL & DONE: Last night marked the 13th time this season that Brooklyn was held to five hits or less...11 of these 13 have come since July 6th, a stretch of 29 games.

ROAD TRIPPIN: Brooklyn is 3-9 over their last 12 road games and have been outscored 62-33 in these games.

RISP, NO REWARD: Brooklyn has gone 3-for-23 with runners in scoring position in their last three games and are hitting .252 (86-341) with RISP this season...Since July 1st the team is batting .219 (56-256) with RISP after batting .341 (29-85) in June....With RISP and two-outs, the team is batting .181 (21-116) over this same period after batting .419 (18-43) in June.

RUNNING AT WILL: Since July 21st, the Brooklyn Cyclones have allowed 30 stolen bases over the span of 16 games...Brooklyn ranks last in the league with a .243 caught stealing percentage (17-70)...Conversely, Brooklyn is 27-46 on stolen base attempts for a 58.7% success rate, worst in the NYPL.

KEEP ON K'ING: Brooklyn has struck out 46 times in their last four games...The 'Clones have 380 k's on the year, second most in the league, behind only Lowell's 403 strikeouts.
