LAST GAME: The Cyclones were shut out for the second time this season on Monday night, falling in Vermont 1-0...**Jeff Walters** (2-4) was the hard luck loser for the Cyclones despite Cyclones went 0-5 with RISP and the last 11 batters were retired in order....**T.J. Chism** struck out six in 2.1 innings of work out of the bullpen and **Charley Thurber** was the only Cyclone with multiple hits in the game.

CYCLONES VS. WILLIAMSPORT: The Cyclones are 33-22 all-time against the Crosscutters...Brooklyn and Williamsport shared the 2001 New York-Penn League Championship and lost to the 'Cutters in 2003.

AT THE GAME TODAY: The Cyclones will begin a three-game series against the Williamsport Crosscutters...The Inflatamaniacs will make their MCU Park debut and following the game, everyone gets to run the bases.

NEXT HOME GAME: Tomorrow will be the second day game of the season and MCU Park will be invaded by Summer Camps from throughout the city...It will also be EVERYONE runs the bases post-game.

DILLON GEE NIGHT: On Thursday, August 4th former Cyclone hurler and current New York Mets pitcher Dillon Gee will be on hand for a special pre-game ceremony.

3,000,000 AND GROWING: The Cyclones welcomed their 3,000,000th fan to MCU Park on Wednesday, July 27th reaching the milestone quicker than any short season franchise in Minor League Baseball history.

CHARLES IN CHARGE: Cyclones out-fallen in Vermont 1-0...**Jeff Walters** (2-4) was the hard luck loser for the Cyclones despite allowing only the single run in 4.2 innings...The

M-OH NO!: Shortstop **Danny Munro** is hitting less in his last five games and is 0-13 over the span...Prior to this stretch, the 8th round pick from Fresno State had never gone more than two games without a hit.

RISP: The Cyclones have been struggling with runners in scoring position over their last seven games, batting .163 (8-49) including just 5-26 in the four game series against the Vermont Lake Monsters.

WON AND DONE: Cyclones starters have combined for just one win since July 15th. In 17 starts since July 15th, the rotation is 1-5 with a 5.98 ERA (42 ER / 70.2 IP) over the span.

LEAGUE LEADERS: **Richard Lucas** currently ranks third in the the NYPL with a .342 average...**Danny Munro** ranks fifth at .331...The pair also lead the league in on-base percentage... Lucas also leads the NYPL in runs (33)...**Travis Taijeron**'s league-leading .600 slugging percentage is .029 points higher than the second-ranked slugger...**Eduardo Aldama**'s 48 strikeouts rank second. The righty has a K/9 ratio of 10.8.

NO BULL: Since the start of the season the Brooklyn bullpen as a whole has inherited 55 runners and allowing only seven of them to score (12.7%)...By comparison, the Los Angeles Angels of Anaheim bullpen leads MLB with a 21.3 % (26-122).

TONIGHT'S STARTER : RHP # 12 Randy Fontanez (0-0, 2.60 ERA)

- Has a 1.54 ERA in 11.2 innings as a starter and a 4.76 ERA in 5.2 innings as a reliever.
- Is holding the opposition to a .230 batting average.
- While at the University of South Florida, he struck out 12 batters en route to tossing a no-hitter vs. Notre Dame on 3/26/10. The no-no was the first of the 2010 Division I baseball season and the first in USF history in 18 years.
- Despite finishing his senior season with a 5-6 record, he pitched 7.0 innings or more in 10 of his 14 starts.
- The anchor of the USF pitching staff for four years, Fontanez earned All-BIG EAST Second-Team honors his senior season, making him the first player to be named to the All-BIG EAST Team three years straight.
- His five total BIG EAST Pitcher of the Week awards are tied for second most in conference history.
