Mahoning Valley Scrappers (8-11) vs. Brooklyn Cyclones (10-9)

TONIGHT'S STARTER: LHP Brad Holt (1-2, 2.45) makes his fourth start of the season, and his second at KeySpan Park. In his last start (7/1 @ HV), he allowed two runs, one earned, on four hits in 3.2 innings. In the start prior to that (6/26 vs. ABD), Brad tossed five no-hit innings, before leaving the game due to a pitch count.

Holt was selected by the Mets in the supplemental round of the June draft (33rd overall). He posted an 11-1 record with a 3.18 ERA for UNC Wilmington in 2008, while setting career-bests in wins (11), innings pitched (93.1), strikeouts (95) and opponent batting average (.225) Holt ranks second all-time at UNCW in single-season wins, winning his final 11 decisions of the 2008 season. He was named First-Team Colonial Athletic Association, and also earned a third-team spot on the Louisville Slugger All-America squad.

In 2007, Brad made 15 starts for UNCW and finished with a 5-5 mark with a 5.90 ERA and 53 strikeouts in 76.1 innings. In 2006, he made eight starts in 14 games, going 3-3 with a 3.48 ERA with 42 strikeouts in 54.1 innings pitched.

In high school, Brad earned NCPreps.com 1A All-State honors, All-Watkin Valley Conference honors four times, All-County selection four times, and Louisville Slugger Second-team All-American while attending Albemarle HS in North Carolina.

LAST GAME: The Cyclones lost an extra-inning affair on Saturday, by a score of 6-1, when Mahoning Valley plated five runs in the 10th inning. The loss drops Brooklyn to a game over .500, bringing the Cyclones' record to 10-9.

2B **Josh Satin** hit the Cyclones' first home run of the year at home; it came in the bottom of the fourth inning to score Brooklyn first and only run of the game. SS **Reese Havens** continued his hot hitting, picking up a pair of hits and raising his average to .250. 1B **Ike Davis** also extended his hitting streak to ten games, with at least one hit in every game in which he's played.

RHP **Scott Shaw** made the start for the Cyclones, pitching 5.1 innings and allowing just one run. LHP **Jimmy Johnson** relieved Shaw and pitched a scoreless two thirds of an inning.

RHP **Chris Schwinden** (0-1) picked up the loss, tossing 3.0 innings, giving up four hits and allowing two runs. LHP **Matias Carrillo** came on in the 10th and allowed two walks and gave up a grand slam.

EXTRA INNINGS: Brooklyn has played three extra-inning games this season, going 1-2 in those contests. The Cyclones entered the season 35-29 all-time in extra-inning games, and went 5-2 in 2007.

ZACH ATTACK: 3B **Zach Lutz** leads the team with a .354 average (17-for-48), and nine RBI. Lutz also leads the team with 13 walks, and a .492 on-base percentage. Lutz has a .479 slugging percentage and a .971 OPS. Zach's average ranks eighth among qualifiers in the NYPL, and his on-base percentage is best in the league.

Lutz was the Cyclones' Opening Day starter in 2007, but broke his foot after just two at-bats, and required season-ending surgery. After almost a full year of rehab, he returned to the field in early June and was once again Brooklyn's Opening Day starter at third base in 2008.

Lutz was drafted by the Mets in the fifth round in 2007, out of Alvernia College (PA) where he was a two-time Pennsylvania Athletic Conference Baseball Player of the Year, and was named Division III National Player of the Year in 2007 by the National Collegiate Baseball Writers Association.

IKE STRIKES: 1B **Ike Davis** has at least one hit in every game in which he's played, a streak of 10 games, entering Sunday's contest. Davis was the Mets' first pick of the first round in the June draft, 18th overall, out of Arizona State University.

iB/OF **Lucas Duda** set the franchise record last season with a 17-game hitting streak.

WHEN YURY'S IN, YOU'RE OUT: RHP **Yury Santana** leads the team and the NYPL with five saves. The former infielder (who played shortstop for the Cyclones in 2005) has not allowed a hit in five of his six appearances. He surrendered two runs on three hits in one inning on 6/30 vs. HV, but has been otherwise untouchable. In total, he is 1-0 with five saves, and a 2.84 ERA. He has allowed three hits in 6.1 IP, with three walks, and 11 strikeouts.

STARRING FROM BROOKLYN TO BINGHAMTON: Four of the five Binghamton Mets recently named to the Double-A Eastern League All-Star Game -- RHP **Sal Aguilar**, 1B/OF **Nick Evans**, 3B **Dan Murphy**, and RHP **Bobby Parnell** -- are former Brooklyn Cyclones. The fifth B-Met All-Star is 1B/OF Mike Carp.

Aguilar (10-1, 2.83), Evans (.307, 50 R, 13 HR, 51 RBI), and Parnell (8-4, 4.04) all played for Brooklyn in 2005, while Murphy (.322, 44 R, 9 HR, 50 RBI) was originally a Cyclone in 2006, and also rehabbed with the team earlier this season.

PACKING THE PARK: The Cyclones have led the NYPL -- and the entire Short-Season classification -- in attendance in each of the team's first seven years of existence. Brooklyn is again leading the league in 2008, with **64,788** fans in nine openings, for an average of **7,199**.

In 2007 the Cyclones drew 294,972 fans in 36 openings, for an average of 8,194 fans per game (up from 7,820 in 2007). The team topped 9,000 fans on six separate occasions, and set a new all-time high with 10,073 fans on 9/7/07 vs. Lowell.
