OPENING DAY: The Cyclones are 10-2 all-time on Opening Day...Brooklyn has not lost an Opening Day game since 2006 when they fell to the Staten Island Yankees 18-0 at what was then KeySpan Park...The Cyclones have opened the season against the Staten Island Yankees nine times, with Brooklyn going 8-1 in these contests...Brooklyn shutout Staten Island 2-0 on Opening Day, June 18th, at MCU Park last season... RHP **Dawrin Frias** collected the win for Brooklyn on Opening Day...The following day, the Cyclones defeated the Yankees 4-1 at Richmond County Bank Ballpark in the Baby Bombers home opener.

HOME OPENER: The Cyclones will open their 2013 home schedule on Tuesday at 7:00 PM against these same Staten Island Yankees...The Cyclones will be wearing special "come-then Back" jerseys featuring the names of 38 communities impacted by Superstorm Sandy...These jerseys will be raffled and auctioned off throughout the season with proceeds to benefit the Cyclones "Meaningful Monday" charities...In a special pre-game ceremony, Cyclones players and coaches will be joined for pre-game introductions by children from Brooklyn, Queens, Staten Island and Long Island who were impacted by Superstorm Sandy.

VS. STATEN ISLAND: The Cyclones hold an 81-73 advantage over Staten Island during the all-time series...Brooklyn went 8-6 against the Yankees in 2012 and 9-5 during the 2011 campaign...Last season, Brooklyn had three of their league leading 10 shutouts against Staten Island.

IN THE GENES: Cyclones 2B **L.J. Mazzilli**, son of former New York Mets OF Lee Mazzilli, is the latest son of a former professional athlete to suit up for the Cyclones...He joins a list including 1B **James Burt** (2004), son of former NY Giant and Super Bowl Champion Jim Burt, 1B **Ike Davis** (2008), son of big league pitcher Ron Davis, and RHP **Dan Foli** (2004), son of big leaguer and former #1 overall pick Tim Foli.

RICHY RICH: Cyclones manager **Rich Donnelly** returns to guide the Cyclones for the third consecutive season...He is the first manager in franchise history to be at the helm for three consecutive seasons...Rich enters play this season with a record of 90-60 (.600) and has the second most wins in franchise history behind Edgar Alfonzo (146).

FIRST THINGS FIRST: There are only two players in franchise history who have been in the Opening Day starting lineup for both the Brooklyn Cyclones and New York Mets...

Mike Jacobs was the starting catcher for the first game in franchise history in 2001, and was the starting 1B for the Mets in 2010...OF **Lucas Duda** began his professional career with the Cyclones in 2007 and has been in the Opening Day lineup for the Mets in 2012 and 2013.

THE GIVING OF GAVIN: Cyclones SS **Gavin Cecchini**, who was impacted by Hurricane Rita in his Lake Charles home as an 11-year-old, saw the damage caused by Superstorm Sandy in the New York City area last fall and donated \$10,000 to the Mayor's Fund for Sandy Relief.

DON'T HATE THE PLAIA: Brooklyn backstop **Colton Plaia** was recently selected in the 15th round of the 2013 MLB Draft out of Loyola Marymount University...Prior to attending LMU, he was a star at JSerra high school where he was coached by former Brooklyn Cyclones catcher, and fan favorite, **Brett Kay**, who starred for the Cyclones in 2001.

FIRST THINGS FIRST: SS **Gavin Cecchini**, who was selected 12th overall in the 2012 MLB Draft, is the highest drafted player to ever suit up for the Brooklyn Cyclones... He is the 11th first round selection overall to play in BKLYN.

- Made two spot starts with St. Lucie (A) of the Florida State League earlier this season, going 1-0 with a 3.00 ERA...He allowed just three runs on five hits over 9.0 innings.
- Also made five starts with Savannah (A) from May 11th - June 5th...Went 2-3 with a 3.72 ERA over 29.0 innings...Allowed two earned runs or less in three of these five outings.
- Made five starts with the Kingsport Mets (R) of the Appalachian League in 2011...Had his best outing of the season on August 27th vs. Pulaski, tossing 6.2 shutout innings, allowing just four hits while striking out five.
- Was a two sport star at Westchester HS starring on the baseball diamond and basketball court...His team finished the 2010 basketball season ranked #3 nationally by Max Preps.
