HOME OPENER: The Cyclones are 10-2 all-time in Home Openers...Brooklyn lost to Staten Island in 2006 and 2011 for their only blemishes...The Cyclones are 8-2 against the Baby Bombers in MCU Park Home Openers...Brooklyn shutout the Staten Island 2-0 on June 18th, the home opener, at MCU Park last season...RHP **Dawrin Frias** collected the win for Brooklyn.

LAST NIGHT: The Cyclones fell on Opening Day for only the third time in franchise history, dropping one to the Staten Island Yankees 2-1 at Richmond County Bank Ballpark...Staten Island scored both runs thanks to a throwing error from 3B **Anthony Chavez** in the second inning...OF **James Roche** provided the lone tally for Brooklyn with a solo home run in the seventh inning.

VS. STATEN ISLAND: The Cyclones hold an 81-74 advantage over Staten Island during the all-time series...Brooklyn went 8-6 against the Yankees in 2012 and 9-5 during the 2011 campaign...Last season, Brooklyn had three of their league leading 10 shutouts against Staten Island.

RICHY RICH: Cyclones manager **Rich Donnelly** returns to guide the Cyclones for the third consecutive season...He is the first manager in franchise history to be at the helm for three consecutive seasons...Rich enters play this season with a record of 90-61 (.596) and has the second most wins in franchise history behind Edgar Alfonzo (146).

THE GIVING OF GAVIN: Cyclones SS **Gavin Cecchini**, who was impacted by Hurricane Rita in his Lake Charles home as an 11-year-old, saw the damage caused by Superstorm Sandy in the New York City area last fall and donated \$10,000 to the Mayor's Fund for Sandy Relief.

PRE-GAME: As the Cyclones open their 2013 home schedule, the team will also kick off their year long initiative to raise for those impacted by Superstorm Sandy...The Cyclones will be wearing special "comeBack" jerseys featuring the names of 38 communities impacted by Superstorm Sandy... These jerseys will be raffled and auctioned off throughout the season with proceeds to benefit the Cyclones "Meaningful Monday" charities...In a special pre-game ceremony, Cyclones players and coaches will be joined for pre-game introductions by children from Brooklyn, Queens, Staten Island and Long Island who were impacted by Superstorm Sandy.

IN THE GENES: Cyclones 2B **L.J. Mazzilli**, son of former New York Mets OF Lee Mazzilli, is the latest son of a former professional athlete to suit up for the Cyclones...He joins a list including 1B **James Burt** (2004), son of former NY Giant and Super Bowl Champion Jim Burt, 1B **Ike Davis** (2008), son of big league pitcher Ron Davis, and RHP **Dan Foli** (2004), son of big leaguer and former #1 overall pick Tim Foli.

DON'T HATE THE PLAIA: Brooklyn backstop **Colton Plaia** was recently selected in the 15th round of the 2013 MLB Draft out of Loyola Marymount Univeristy...Prior to attending LMU, he was a star at JSerra high school where he was coached by former Brooklyn Cyclones catcher, and fan favorite, **Brett Kay**, who starred for the Cyclones in 2001.

ROSTER MOVE: LHP Paul Paez, selected in the 37th round of the 2013 MLB Draft, has signed with the Mets and reported to Brooklyn...The southpaw went 9-1 with a 2.26 ERA for Rio Hondo JC, striking out 96 batters in 83.2 innings.

FIELD TURF: The Cyclones are one of only four teams in MiLB with a FieldTurf playing surface...The new field cost over \$1 million and is built to withstand severe weather.
