**LAST GAME:** For the second straight game, a Cyclones defensive miscue provided the winning margin as the Yankees defeated the Cyclones on Wednesday evening, 5-2... **Matt Oberste** went 3-for-4 with a home run and two RBI in only his second game as a professional...**David Wynn** and **Cristian Chivilli** combined to toss 3.1 scoreless innings of relief, allowing just a single hit while striking out six, but the damage was done against Cyclones starter **Miller Diaz**, who allowed five runs, two earned, over 4.2 innings.

**HOME OPENER:** The Cyclones are 10-2 all-time in Home Openers...Brooklyn lost to Staten Island in 2006 and 2011 for their only blemishes...Tonight marks the first time since 2004 that the Cyclones have opened their home slate against a team besides Staten Island thanks to Tuesday's rain out.

**VS. ABERDEEN:** The Cyclones hold a 71-38 advantage over the IronBirds since 2002 when Aberdeen entered the league... These two teams have finished first and second in average attendance in the NYPL every year since 2002...The Cyclones went 6-4 against Aberdeen in 2012, and are 23-7 against the IronBirds since 2010, including a 12-3 mark at home.

**RICHY RICH:** Cyclones manager **Rich Donnelly** returns to guide the Cyclones for the third consecutive season...He is the first manager in franchise history to be at the helm for three consecutive seasons...Rich enters play this season with a record of 90-62 (.592) and has the second most wins in franchise history behind Edgar Alfonzo (146).

**RAIN OUT:** Those with tickets for Tuesday night's game that was postponed due to rain can exchange their ticket for any game during the remainder of the 2013 season, based on availability...You must bring your ticket stub with you when making the exchange.

**KING'S COUNTY:** OF **Jared King**, the Mets 5th Round Pick in the 2013 MLB Draft out of Kansas State, has signed with the Mets and reported to Brooklyn...He is in the starting lineup this evening and will make his professional debut... The 21-year-old outfielder ranked in the top 10 in eight of the Big 12 this season, and hit .327 (69-211) for the Wildcats.

**ST. PATRICK'S DAY:** OF **Patrick Biondi**, the Mets 9th round selection out of the University of Michigan has been assigned to the Cyclones and is in tonight's starting lineup... Stole 103 bases and hit .303 during his time with the Wolverines and was twice named captain of the team.

**IN THE GENES:** Cyclones 2B **L.J. Mazzilli**, son of former New York Mets OF Lee Mazzilli, is the latest son of a former professional athlete to suit up for the Cyclones...He joins a list including 1B **James Burt** (2004), son of former NY Giant and Super Bowl Champion Jim Burt, 1B **Ike Davis** (2008), son of big league pitcher Ron Davis, and RHP **Dan Foli** (2004), son of big leaguer and former #1 overall pick Tim Foli.

**DON'T HATE THE PLAIA:** Brooklyn backstop **Colton Plaia** was recently selected in the 15th round of the 2013 MLB Draft out of Loyola Marymount Univeristy...Prior to attending LMU, he was a star at JSerra high school where he was coached by former Brooklyn Cyclones catcher, and fan favorite, **Brett Kay**, who starred for the Cyclones in 2001.

**ROSTER MOVE:** LHP Paul Paez, selected in the 37th round of the 2013 MLB Draft, has signed with the Mets and reported to Brooklyn...The southpaw went 9-1 with a 2.26 ERA for Rio Hondo JC, striking out 96 batters in 83.2 innings.
