LAST GAME: The Cyclones handed the Renegades their first loss of the season on Sunday night, winning by the score of 5-4 (17-54) leading off an inning...OF **Patrick Biondi** is batting .429 (4-3 in 13 innings)...CF **Patrick Biondi** went 3-for-5 and his (3-7) to start a frame.

two out, ninth inning single scored OF **James Roche** and knotted the game at 3-3...In the 13th it was Roche who ended the game with a line drive single to left field that just eluded Renegades OF Granden Goetzman and allowed OF **Jared King** to score the winning run...LHP **John Mincone** (1-0) got the win after tossing 2.0 perfect innings, striking out five.

VS. HUDSON VALLEY: The Cyclones hold a 63-44 advantage in the all-time series against the Renegades...Brooklyn went 7-3 against the Renegades in 2012...Hudson Valley only had 24 losses all season...The Renegades won the McNamara Division title last season, marking the first time since 2001 that Staten Island or Brooklyn didn't win the division.

100 WINNING WAYS: Cyclones manager **Rich Donnelly** returns to guide the Cyclones for the third consecutive season...He is the first manager in franchise history to be at the helm for three consecutive seasons...Rich enters play this season with a record of 93-63 (.596) and has the second most wins in franchise history behind Edgar Alfonzo (146).

BULLS IN THE PEN: Through the first six games of the 2013 season, the Cyclones bullpen has allowed only three earned run over their 25.0 innings of work...Brooklyn relievers have combined for 38 strikeouts over these 25.0 innings...LHP **David Wynn** and LHP **John Mincone** did not allow a base runner over the final 5.0 innings of Sunday's 13 inning marathon.

PITCHING IN: Last night's 1:11 delay due to Hudson Valley's transportation issue was the latest in odd stopages in Cyclones history, joining fog, sun and rain.

FIRST THINGS FIRST: The Cyclones are hitting .315 (17-54) leading off an inning...OF **Patrick Biondi** is batting .429 (4-3 in 13 innings)...CF **Patrick Biondi** went 3-for-5 and his (3-7) to start a frame.

ALRIGHT AGAINST LEFT: As a team, the Cyclones are batting .311 (19-61) against southpaws and just .233 (35-150) against righthanded pitchers.

LIFE IS GREAT AFTER EIGHT: LHP **John Mincone** recorded the final out of Friday night's game to collect his second save of the early season...In franchise history, the Cyclones are 431-13 when leading after eight innings.

GAVIN GETS GOING: SS **Gavin Cecchini** began the season 0-for-7 over his first two games, but has gone 7-17 (.412) over his last four games including three multi-hit performances.

TO ERR IS HUMAN: The Cyclones have committed five errors through the first six games of the season...These five runs have led to eight unearned runs scoring...In Brooklyn's three losses this season, they have allowed 12 runs, with eight of the 12 coming as a result of an error.

DOUBLE DIP: Tuesday's game, which was postponed due to rain, has been rescheduled as part of a one-admission doubleheader on Monday, July 1st...The teams will play two, seven inning games starting at 6:00 PM.

PITCHING IN: The Cyclones pitching staff currently leads the NYPL with a .174 ERA (11 ER / 57.0 IP)...They also rank third in the league with 62 strikeouts, despite playing one game less than most teams.
