**100 WINNING WAYS:** Cyclones manager **Rich Donnelly** returns to guide the Cyclones for the third consecutive season...He is the first manager in franchise history to be at the helm for three consecutive seasons...Rich enters play this season with a record of 94-64 (.595) and has the second most wins in franchise history behind Edgar Alfonzo (146). **POWER OUTAGE:** The Cyclones hit a home run in each of their first two games of the 2013 campaign, but not have connected on a long ball since...As a team, Brooklyn only has 11 extra base hits, third fewest in the league, in front of only Staten Island (10) and Lowell (7)...On the mound, Cyclones pitchers are the only staff in the NYPL to not surrender a long ball...Brooklyn pitching has faced 314 batters over 75.2 innings and have yet to give up a round tripper.

**BULLS IN THE PEN:** Over their last 16.2 innings of work, the Cyclones bullpen has allowed only one run, dating to the sixth inning of Sunday's game...Brooklyn relievers have allowed just six earned runs through the first 38.2 innings of the 2013 season. **ROSTER MOVES:** Prior to Tuesday's game, RHP **Cristian Chivilli** was transferred to the Kingsport (R) roster, but will stay in Brooklyn...OF **Julio Concepcion** was placed on the Disabled List...In addition, RHP **Ricky Knapp** and RHP **Kevin McGowan**, both selected in the 2013 MLB Draft, were activated...Lastly, LHP **Shawn Teufel** joined the Cyclones on a minor league rehab assignment...The southpaw went 0-0 with a 4.26 ERA in 15 games with Binghamton (AA).

**ALRIGHT AGAINST LEFT:** As a team, the Cyclones are batting .324 (24-74) against southpaws and just .211 (44-209) against righthanded pitchers.
