LAST GAME: Brooklyn lost their third straight game, falling to Aberdeen 7-5 on Thursday night...For the second time in three games, the Cyclones blew an early lead after jumping in front 5-1 after three innings...LHP David Wynn (0-2) surrendered a two-out, bases loaded double with two outs in the fifth inning that allowed three runs to score and gave Aberdeen a 6-5 advantage...2B Juan Gamboa had a two-RBI double, and SS Gavin Cecchini, OF Jorge Rivero and 1B Matt Oberste each had multi-hit games.

THE WAIT IS THE HARDEST PART: Through 10 games, the Cyclones have had games delayed by over 320 minutes...In addition they had one game cancelled due to rain (June 18 vs. SI) and one game called early due to rain (June 26 at ABD).
JORGE, JORGE: Cyclones OF Jorge Rivero has four multi-hit games in six starts this season...This season, every game in which he has collected a hit, has been a multi-hit game.

HUDSON VALLEY: The Cyclones hold a 64-45 advantage in the all-time series against the Renegades...Brooklyn went 7-3 against the Renegades in 2012...Hudson Valley only had 24 losses all season...The Renegades won the McNamara Division title last season, marking the first time since 2001 that Staten Island or Brooklyn didn't win the division.

A-KKK-EEL MORRIS: Cyclones reliever RHP Akeel Morris ranks third in the league with a 17.55 strikeouts / per nine IP ratio...In 6.2 innings, he has 13 strikeouts.
POWER OUTAGE: The Cyclones hit a home run in each of their first two games of the 2013 campaign, but not have connected on a long ball since...As a team, Brooklyn only has 14 extra base hits, second fewest in the league, in front of only Lowell (13)...On the mound, Cyclones pitchers are the only staff in the NYPL to not surrender a long ball...Brooklyn pitching has faced 381 batters over 90.2 innings and have yet to give up a round tripper.

100 WINNING WAYS: Cyclones manager Rich Donnelly returns to guide the Cyclones for the third consecutive season...He is the first manager in franchise history to be at the helm for three consecutive seasons...Rich enters play this season with a record of 94-66 (.588) and has the second most wins in franchise history behind Edgar Alfonzo (146).

THE FUTURE IS NOW: The Cyclones will be well represented in the XM Futures Game on July 14th at Citi Field...Former Brooklyn Manager Mookie Wilson will manage the U.S. team, former Brooklyn trainer Mike Herbst will serve in the same role for Team USA as well. Pedro Lopez, who guided the Cyclones in 2009, will serve as a coach for the World Team...In addition, RHP Rafael Montero will play in the game for the World Team...OF Brandon Nimmo, a member of the 2012 Cyclones, is a Futures Finalist where fans can vote for the last player to make the roster for the game.

NO E IN WIN: Through 10 games, the Cyclones have committed 13 errors...In their four wins, the team has three errors with two unearned runs...In their six losses, the team has 10 errors with 10 unearned runs.

RUNNING AT WILL: The Cyclones have allowed 22 stolen bases in 29 attempts this season...Brooklyn leads the league in caught stealing (7) as well as stolen bases allowed (22)...Williamsport is the only other team with at least 20 stolen base attempts against them.
