LAST GAME: Brooklyn was shutout for the second straight game, losing to Hudson Valley 1-0 at Dutchess Stadium in 11 in their last 23 innings dating to the sixth inning on June 28th innings...The loss wasted an outstanding performance from at Hudson Valley...The team has scored in only six of their Brooklyn starter RHP Rob Gsellman, who tossed 8.0 shutout last 55 innings dating to the second frame of the June 25th innings, allowing just four hits while striking out four...The contest at Hudson Valley.

Cyclones lone scoring chance came in the eight inning when OF Jorge Rivero was thrown out trying to score from third on an infield grounder...LHP John Mincone (0-1) was tagged with the loss after allowing the game winning to score with one out in the 11th.

VS. STATEN ISLAND: The Cyclones hold an 81-75 advantage over Staten Island during the all-time series...Brooklyn went 8-6 against the Yankees in 2012 and 9-5 during the 2011 campaign...Last season, Brooklyn had three of their league leading 10 shutouts against Staten Island.

DOUBLE SHUTOUT: The Cyclones have been shutout in back-to-back games for only the second time in franchise history and the first time since August 27-29, 2002 when the Cyclones were held scoreless during an entire three-game series against the Staten Island Yankees.

100 WINNING WAYS: Cyclones manager Rich Donnelly returns to guide the Cyclones for the third consecutive season...He is the first manager in franchise history to be at the helm for three consecutive seasons...Rich currently has a record of 95-68 (.590) and has the second most wins in franchise history behind Edgar Alfonzo (146).

RUNNING AT WILL: The Cyclones have allowed 30 stolen bases in 37 attempts this season...The Cyclones are the only team to allow more than 20 stolen bases and have had 10 more stolen bases attempts against them than any other team in the league (Staten Island - 27).

RUNNING ON EMPTY: The Cyclones have not scored a run game, losing to Hudson Valley 1-0 at Dutchess Stadium in 11 in their last 23 innings dating to the sixth inning on June 28th innings...The loss wasted an outstanding performance from at Hudson Valley...The team has scored in only six of their Brooklyn starter RHP Rob Gsellman, who tossed 8.0 shutout last 55 innings dating to the second frame of the June 25th innings, allowing just four hits while striking out four...The contest at Hudson Valley.

BELOW .500: Today marks the sixth consecutive day that the Cyclones are under the .500 mark...That is the longest time below the .500 mark since the team spent 36 days below .500 to start the 2006 campaign...The Cyclones rallied that year and finished 41-33 and made the playoffs as a Wild Card.

THE WAIT IS THE HARDEST PART: Through 13 games, the Cyclones have had games delayed by over 320 minutes... In addition they had one game cancelled due to rain (June 18 vs. SI) and one game called early due to rain (June 26 at ABD).

POWER OUTAGE: The Cyclones hit a home run in each of their first two games of the 2013 campaign, but have not connected on a long ball since...As a team, Brooklyn only has 17 extra base hits, fewest in the league...On the mound, Cyclones pitchers are the only staff in the NYPL to not surrender a long ball...Brooklyn pitching has faced 504 batters over 119.0 innings and have yet to give up a round tripper.

WHO'S HOT: SS Gavin Cecchini is batting .342 (13-38) over his last nine games...1B Matt Oberste is hitting .368 (7-19) over his last five contests.

WHO'S NOT: As a team, the Cyclones are batting .202 (34-168) over their last five games...2B L.J. Mazzilli is just 1-for-15 over the last five games and just 3-for-28 (.107) over his last seven contests.
