LAST GAME: The Cyclones won their third straight on Monday night, knocking off the Lowell Spinners, 4-3...OF **Jared King** broke a 3-3 tie in the bottom of the eighth with an RBI double that scored OF **Patrick Biondi** to give Brooklyn the win...OF **James Roche** also added a two-hit effort with a pair of RBI...RHP **Cristian Chivilli** (2-0) collected with win after tossing 2.0 innings of relief and LHP **Shawn Teufel** closed out the game for his third save of the year.

VS. LOWELL: The Cyclones have a 38-25 advantage in the all-time series against the Spinners...Lowell took the 2012 series from the Cyclones 4-2, including going 2-1 at MCU Park.

100 WINNING WAYS: Cyclones manager **Rich Donnelly** returns to guide the Cyclones for the third consecutive season...He is the first manager in franchise history to be at the helm for three consecutive seasons...Rich currently has a record of 99-72 (.579) and has the second most wins in franchise history behind Edgar Alfonzo (146).

BELOW .500: Today marks the 14th consecutive day that the Cyclones are under the .500 mark...That is the longest time below the .500 mark since the team spent 36 days below .500 to start the 2006 campaign...The Cyclones rallied that year and finished 41-33 and made the playoffs as a Wild Card.

TO INFINITY AND BIONDI: OF **Patrick Biondi** is currently tied for first in the NYPL with 11 stolen bases on the season...In 2012, OF **Eudy Pina** led the Cyclones with 10 stolen bases on the entire season and in 2009 SS **Danny Muno** led Brooklyn with nine stolen bases...The Cyclones already have 19 stolen bases this year, after stealing only 23 all of last season...Biondi has eight stolen bases in his last seven games.

EXTRA EXTRA: The Cyclones have already played seven extra inning games this season, most in the New York-Penn League...The Cyclones played a club record 13 extra inning games during the 2002 season.

POWER OUTAGE: The Cyclones hit a home run in each of their first two games of the 2013 campaign, but have hit only one home run since...Brooklyn ranks last in the NYPL with three home runs and has only 38 extra-base hits on the season, which is tied for 12th in the league.

POWER SURGE: After not allowing a home run through the first 123.0 inning of the season, Cyclones pitchers have allowed seven home runs in the last eight games.

WHO'S HOT: 2B **L.J. Mazzilli** has hit safely in six of his last eight games and is batting .355 (11-31) over the span...INF **Juan Gamboa** has three multi-hit games in his last five outings and is batting .316 (6-19)...OF **Jorge Rivero** currently has a six-game hittin streak and is batting .417 (10-24) over the span.

WHO'S NOT: 1B **Matt Oberste** is 1-20 over his last five games and is batting just .147 (5-34) over his last eight contests...OF **James Roche** is 3-for-16 over his last four games with 11 strikeouts.

RUN PATTY RUN: OF **Patrick Biondi** has scored at least one run in five straight games (seven runs total) after scoring only two runs in the first 11 games of his professional career.

HOME SWEET HOME: OF **James Roche** is batting .346 (9-26) with three doubles and a triple at MCU Park and is batting just .167 (6-36) on the road.
