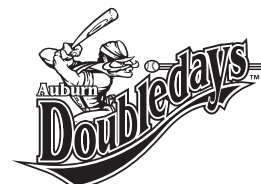


## BROOKLYN CYCLONES (9-13) at AUBURN DOUBLEDAYS (7-14)

**LAST GAME:** The Spinners snapped Brooklyn's three-game winning streak on Tuesday afternoon, defeating the Cyclones to Savannah (A) of the South Atlantic League...Rivero was 5-2...Brooklyn committed three errors, which led to a pair of hitting .339 (21-62) with four doubles and four RBI and was unearned runs for Lowell...OF **Jorge Rivero** went 2-for-4 in the midst of a seven-game hitting streak. with two RBI in a losing effort for the Cyclones.

**ROAD WOES:** OF **James Roche** is batting .167 (6-36) in 10

**VS. AUBURN:** The Cyclones have a 22-16 advantage in the road games, including 14 strikeouts... **C Tomas Nido** is just all-time series against the Doubledays...Brooklyn went 3-0 2-for-19 in road games...The Cyclones as a team are just 3-9 against the Doubledays last season, allowing only two runs on the road and have been outscored 49-36. in the three game series.

**100 WINNING WAYS:** Cyclones manager **Rich Donnelly** returns to guide the Cyclones for the third consecutive season...He is the first manager in franchise history to be at the helm for three consecutive seasons...Rich currently has a record of 99-73 (.576) and has the second most wins in franchise history behind Edgar Alfonzo (146).

**ALRIGHT AGAINST LEFT:** 1B **Matt Oberste** is batting .316 (6-19) against lefthanded pitchers this season as compared to .194 (12-62) against righthanded pitching... 3B **Anthony Chavez** is hitting .316 (6-19) against leftied and .213 (10-47) against righthanders.

**WHO'S HOT:** OF **Jared King** is hitting .438 (7-16) over his last five games...King also has four walks in these games as well.

**BELOW .500:** Today marks the 15th consecutive day that the Cyclones are under the .500 mark...That is the longest time below the .500 mark since the team spent 36 days below .500 to start the 2006 campaign...The Cyclones rallied that year and finished 41-33 and made the playoffs as a Wild Card.

**WHO'S NOT:** 1B **Matt Oberste** is 2-22 (.091) over his last six games and is batting just .167 (6-36) over his last nine contests...OF **James Roche** is 3-for-16 over his last four games with 11 strikeouts.

**EXTRA EXTRA:** The Cyclones have already played seven extra inning games this season, most in the New York-Penn League...The Cyclones played a club record 13 extra inning games during the 2002 season.

**NO E IN WIN:** In their 13 losses this season, the Cyclones have committed 21 errors, which have led to 16 unearned runs...Brooklyn has an error in 11 of their 12 losses this season...In the nine Cyclones wins, Brooklyn has just seven errors and six unearned runs.

**POWER OUTAGE:** The Cyclones hit a home run in each of their first two games of the 2013 campaign, but have hit only one home run since...Brooklyn ranks last in the NYPL with three home runs and has only 41 extra-base hits on the season, which is tied with Auburn for 12th in the league.

**WHILE WE'RE AWAY:** MCU Park will be used for several events as part of the festivities around the MLB All-Star Game at Citi Field...Friday evening the park will host the Celebrity Softball Challenge, featuring Justin Tuck and Nelly.
