LAST GAME: The Scrappers pounded out 13 hits, including seven over 5.0 innings against Brooklyn starter LHP Dario Alvarez, en route to a 6-2 win on Thursday night...OF Julio Concepcion went 2-for-4 with two runs scored to pace the Cyclones offense...2B L.J. Mazzilli extended his hitting streak to eight games, the longest streak by a Cyclone this season, with a 1-for-4 effort.

VS. MAHONING VALLEY: The Cyclones have a 24-16 advantage in the all-time series against the Scrappers... Brooklyn went 2-1 against the Scrappers last season...The Cyclones played the Scrappers in the first game ever played at what was then KeySpan Park on June 25, 2001.

BELOW .500: Today marks the 25th consecutive day that the Cyclones are under the .500 mark...That is the longest time below the .500 mark since the team spent 36 days below .500 to start the 2006 campaign...The Cyclones rallied that year and finished 41-33 and made the playoffs as a Wild Card.

EXTRA EXTRA: The Cyclones have already played eight extra inning games this season, second most in the New York-Penn League (Hudson Valley, 9)...The Cyclones played a club record 13 extra inning games during the 2002 season... Brooklyn went 5-1 in extra inning games last year.

POWER OUTAGE: The Cyclones hit a home run in each of their first two games of the 2013 campaign, but have hit only two home run since...Brooklyn ranks last in the NYPL with four home runs and has only 61 extra-base hits on the season...Brooklyn's 55 doubles on the season rank fourth in the NYPL...The Cyclones have hit only one home run in 12 games at MCU Park, a solo shot from Juan Gamboa on July 17th vs. Mahoning Valley.

JUSTIN TURNER REHAB: INF Justin Turner will be the 17th player to join the Cyclones on a Minor League Rehab Assignment when he takes the field with Brooklyn this evening...Turner has played six games with the GCL Mets, St. Lucie and, most recently, Binghamton (AA) where he went 6-for-15 (.400) in four games...He made two starts at second base and two starts at shortstop...Turner is rehabbing from a left intercostal strain and last played for the Mets on June 16th...Was batting .266 (25-94) in 44 games with the Mets.

AN A-MAZZ-ING STRETCH: Cyclones 2B L.J. Mazzilli comes into tonight's game with an eight-game hitting streak and is batting .455 (15-33) over this span...The 4th Round Selection in the 2013 MLB Draft has five multi-hit games in his last six games and is batting .500 (13-26) in these games... During July, he is batting .382 (26-68) in 17 games.

SCORING POSITION: Over their last six games, Brooklyn is hitting just .152 (12-79)...On their recent six-game road trip, the Cyclones hit just .161 (13-77) with runners in scoring position...For the season, the Cyclones are batting just .218 (69-317) with RISP and with two outs and RISP the average drops to .187 (28-150)...The 317 at-bats with RISP is the most in the NYPL.

NO E IN WIN: In their 17 losses this season, the Cyclones have committed 27 errors, which have led to 20 unearned runs...Brooklyn has an error in 14 of their 16 losses this season...In the 13 Cyclones wins, Brooklyn has just 11 errors and eight unearned runs.

ALRIGHT VS. LEFT: The Cyclones as a team are batting .274 (78-285) against southpaws this season and .237 (182-768) against RHP...1B Matt Oberste is batting .367 (11-30) against lefties and OF Jared King is hitting .333 (9-27).
