LAST GAME: The Cyclones had their five-game winning streak snapped on Tuesday night, falling to Williamsport charged with just one error in their last seven games...The 1-0...RHP **Seth Lugo** (2-4) was tagged with the loss despite team currently ranks third in the NYPL with a .976 fielding percentage...They have committed 43 errors in 1,497 total walking one and striking out nine...The Cyclones managed

only three hits on the night, but managed to get the tying run to third base in the ninth inning after OF **Patrick Biondi** singled and then stole second and third, but 2B **L.J. Mazzilli** and OF **Jared King** struck out to leave Biondi stranded.

VS. WILLIAMSPORT: The Cyclones hold a 36-26 advantage in the all-time series against the Crosscutters...The Cyclones went 2-1 against the 'Cutters last season in games played at MCU Park.

SHUTOUTS: Last night was the sixth time this season that the Cyclones have been shutout, the most in the New York-Penn League...The six shutouts are the most in a single season since the Cyclones were blanked seven times during the 2009 season...Brooklyn was shut out four times in 2011 and 2012 and just once during the 2010 campaign.

EXTRA EXTRA: The Cyclones have already played nine extra inning games this season, tied for most in the New York-Penn League (Hudson Valley, 9)...The Cyclones played a club record 13 extra inning games during the 2002 season... Brooklyn went 5-1 in extra inning games last year.

POWEROUTAGE: The Cyclones are tied for last in the New York-Penn League with eight home runs on the season (Lowell)...After hitting four home runs through the first 36 games of the season, the Cyclones have four home runs in their last five games...Brooklyn had their first multi-home run game of the season on July 28th vs. Hudson Valley...Williamsport is tied for second in the league with 22 home runs.

THE DEFENSE NEVER RESTS: The Cyclones have been charged with just one error in their last seven games...The 1-0...RHP **Seth Lugo** (2-4) was tagged with the loss despite team currently ranks third in the NYPL with a .976 fielding percentage...They have committed 43 errors in 1,497 total walking one and striking out nine...The Cyclones managed only three hits on the night, but managed to get the tying run to third base in the ninth inning after OF **Patrick Biondi** singled and then stole second and third, but 2B **L.J. Mazzilli** and OF **Jared King** struck out to leave Biondi stranded.

START ME UP: Cyclones starting pitchers have six quality starts in their last seven outings after combining for only seven quality starts through the first 34 games of the season...Over the last 11 games, Brooklyn starting pitchers have an ERA of 1.53 (11 earned runs / 64.2 IP) and have struck out 67 batters during this span.

BULLS IN THE PEN: Cyclones relievers RHP **Akeel Morris** and RHP **Tim Peterson** have yet to allow an earned run this season...Morris has tossed 25.0 innings without allowing an earned run, and Peterson has tossed 16.2 scoreless frames.

SCORING POSITION: Over their last 17 games, Brooklyn is hitting just .158 (25-158) with RISP...For the season, the Cyclones are batting just .207 (82-396) with RISP and with two outs and RISP the average drops to .174 (33-190).

CHAVEZ WITH A K: 3B **Anthony Chavez** has 42 strikeouts on the season, fourth in the league, and has at least one strikeout in his last 17 games dating to July 15th.

NEED FOR SPEED: OF **Patrick Biondi** stole two bases last night and now has 15 swipes on the season, tied for second in the NYPL...The 15 stolen bases are the most by a Cyclone since Darrell Ceciliani had 21 steals during the 2010 season.

WHO'S NOT: OF **Jonathan Clark** is 0-14 since joining the Cyclones...C **Colton Plaia** is just 1-for-18 in his last five...3B **Anthony Chavez** is 2-for-21 (.095) in his last eight.

- Has limited the opposition to .169 (10-59) in three starts on the road.
- Tossed a season-high 5.0 innings in his start on July 11th at Auburn to collect his first win since August 6, 2009 with the DSL Phillies.
- Made his 2013 debut on June 23rd vs. Hudson Valley...Had not pitched in affiliated baseball since the 2009 season.
- In 2012, played in the Venezuelan Winter League for Caribes de Anzoategui.
- Also played in Panama Winter League for Diablos Rojos de Panama in 2012
- In 2011 played for Industriales de Herrera of the Panama Winter League.
- Spent the 2010 campaign with the Softbank Hawks of Japan's Pacific League.
- In his three years of work with the DSL Phillies, only surrendered one home run over 172.2 innings of work.
