**LAST GAME:** Brooklyn fell behind early, trailing 7-1 after their second straight at the hands of the Crosscutters, 8-6... RHP **Dario Alvarez** (1-3) was tagged with the losse after allowing four runs on five hits over his 3.0 innings of work... RHP **Dawrin Frias** also struggled, allowing four runs on six hits in his 4.0 innings of relief... **C Tomas Nido** was the offensive bright spot for Brooklyn, going 2-for-4 with a home run and three RBI.

**VS. WILLIAMSPORT:** The Cyclones hold a 36-26 advantage in the all-time series against the Crosscutters... The Cyclones went 2-1 against the 'Cutters last season in games played at MCU Park.

**EXTRA EXTRA:** The Cyclones have already played nine extra inning games this season, tied for most in the New York-Penn League (Hudson Valley, 9)... The Cyclones played a club record 13 extra inning games during the 2002 season... Brooklyn went 5-1 in extra inning games last year.

**POWER OUTAGE:** The Cyclones are tied for last in the NYPL with nine home runs... After hitting four home runs through the first 36 games of the season, the Cyclones have five home runs in their last six games... Brooklyn had their first multi-home run game of the season on July 28th vs. Hudson Valley... Williamsport is second in the league with 24 home runs.

**THE DEFENSE NEVER RESTS:** The Cyclones have been charged with just two errors in their last eight games... The team currently ranks third in the NYPL with a .973 fielding percentage... They have committed 44 errors in 1,629 total chances.

**START ME UP:** Cyclones starting pitchers have six quality starts in their last eight outings after combining for only 69 batters during this span.

**BULLS IN THE PEN:** Cyclones relievers RHP **Akeel Morris** and RHP **Tim Peterson** have yet to allow an earned run this season... Morris has tossed 25.0 innings without allowing an earned run, and Peterson has tossed 17.2 scoreless frames.

**SCORING POSITION:** Over their last 18 games, Brooklyn is hitting just .163 (27-166) with RISP... For the season, the Cyclones are batting just .208 (84-404) with RISP and with two outs and RISP the average drops to .172 (33-192).

**NEED FOR SPEED:** OF **Patrick Biondi** stole two bases Tuesday night and now has 15 swipes on the season, tied for second in the NYPL... The 15 stolen bases are the most by a Cyclone since Darrell Ceciliani had 21 steals during the 2010 season.

**KING OF KINGS:** OF **Jared King** is riding a five game hitting streak and is batting .412 (7-17) in these games.

**WHO'S NOT:** OF **Jonathan Clark** is 0-14 since joining the Cyclones... **C Colton Plaia** is just 1-for-18 in his last five... **3B Anthony Chavez** is 2-for-22 (.091) in his last nine.

**SIZZLING SANCHEZ:** INF **Alex Sanchez** currently has a five-game hitting streak and is batting .400 (6-15) with five runs scored in these games.

- Currently ranks third in the NYPL with a 1.74 ERA...Is tied for third in the league with a 0.94 WHIP.
- Has allowed two runs or less in five of his seven starts.
- Tossed a career-high 8.0 innings on June 30th at Hudson Valley.
- Was the second youngest Opening Day starting pitcher in franchise history at 19 years, 11 months and 1 day...RHP Gabriel Ynoa was the Opening Day starter for BKLYN in 2012 at just 19 years, 23 days.
- Made two spot starts with St. Lucie (A) of the Florida State League earlier this season, going 1-0 with a 3.00 ERA...He allowed just three runs on five hits over 9.0 innings.
- Also made five starts with Savannah (A) from May 11th - June 5th...Went 2-3 with a 3.72 ERA over 29.0 innings...Allowed two earned runs or less in three of these five outings.
- Was a two sport star at Westchester HS starring on the baseball diamond and basketball court...His team finished the 2010 basketball season ranked #3 nationally by Max Preps.
