LAST GAME: The Cyclones opened their six-game home-stand with a 4-1 loss to the Connecticut Tigers...LHP **Dario Alvarez** (1-4) allowed four runs, one earned, on three hits over his 4.0 innings of work, and was tagged with the loss... RHP **Dawrin Frias** tossed 5.0 shutout frames of relief, striking out nine, but the damage was already done...Offensively, **L.J. Mazzilli** went 2-for-4 with a double and **Juan Gamboa** provided the lone RBI of the game for Brooklyn.

BROOKLYN STARS TO SHINE: The 9th Annual New York-Penn League All-Star Game will be played in Norwich, CT on Tuesday, August 13th...The Cyclones will be well represented in the contest as RHP **Miller Diaz** will be the starting pitcher for the National League Affiliates...In addition 2B **L.J. Mazzilli**, RHP **John Gant**, RHP **Rob Gsellman**, and LHP **John Mincone** were all named to the squad as well...Manager **Rich Donnelly**, and the rest of his coaching staff will guide the NL squad.

VS. CONNECTICUT: The Cyclones are 12-10 against the Connecticut Tigers all-time, including going 2-1 against them in Norwich earlier this season.

POWER SURGE: After hitting four home runs through the first 36 games of the season, the Cyclones have eight home runs in their last 11 games...Brooklyn had their first multi-home run game of the season on July 28th vs. HV when they hit two round trippers...The Cyclones currently rank 13th in the NYPL with 12 home runs on the season.

K-NINE: RHP **Dawrin Frias** struck out nine batters over his 5.0 innings of relief last night...It is the second time this season that the righthander has recorded nine strikeouts out of the bullpen (7/31 at WPT)...The nine k's out of the bullpen are a franchise record for a reliever.

CHANGE OF START: For tomorrow's finale with the Connecticut Tigers, RHP **Ricky Knapp** will make his first professional start when he takes the mound for Brooklyn...The 8th Round Selection in the 2013 MLB Draft from Florida Gulf Coast University went 9-3 with a 2.10 ERA (24 ER/102.2 IP) during his junior campaign.

GETTING IN THE 'FLO: Last night, **Wilmer Flores** started at 3B and batted fifth for the New York Mets and became the 40th former Cyclone to play in the Major Leagues...Flores played for the Cyclones in 2008 at just 17 years old.

INJURY NEWS: Cyclones LF **Jared King** left last night's game with an oblique injury...He is going to be evaluated further today and is considered day-to-day.

A RUN ON RUNS: Brooklyn has scored five runs or more in five of their last six games...The Cyclones scored five or more runs only eight times in their previous 41 games.

GAVIN GETTIN' GOIN: SS **Gavin Cecchini** has hit safely in his last six games and is batting .346 (9-26) over the span...The former 2012 First Round Selection has a double in each of his last three games...The 19-year-old hit just .077 (2-26) during the month of July prior to his hot stretch.

EXTRA EXTRA: OF **James Roche** has 32 hits on the season, with 15 of them going for extra bases...His 12 doubles, one triple and two home runs are all tied for the team lead in each category.

O-FERSTE: 1B **Matt Oberste** is 0-for-20 over his last five games...Since July 18th, the former Oklahoma Sooner is batting just .107 (6-56) with 13 strikeouts in 15 games with an at-bat.
