**LAST GAME:** Cyclones starter RHP John Gant didn't allow a hit until the sixth inning, and allowed just a single run on safely in 10 straight games...It is tied for the longest current two hits over his 6.0 innings, striking out seven as Brooklyn defeated State College 2-1 on Saturday evening...SS Gavin Cecchini continued his hot hitting with a 2-for-4 effort with an RBI to pace the Brooklyn bats...LHP John Mincone and RHP Johnny Magliozzi tossed 3.0 perfect innings to close out the win.

**BROOKLYN STARS TO SHINE:** The 9th Annual New York-Penn League All-Star Game will be played in Norwich, CT on Tuesday, August 13th...The Cyclones will be well represented in the contest as RHP Miller Diaz will be the starting pitcher for the National League Affiliates...In addition 2B L.J. Mazzilli, RHP John Gant, RHP Rob Gsellman, and LHP John Mincone were all named to the squad as well...Manager, Rich Donnelly, and the rest of his coaching staff will guide the NL squad.

**VS. STATE COLLEGE:** The Cyclones are 17-6 against the Spikes all-time...Brooklyn went 3-0 against State College last season and is 9-2 against them over the last four seasons...State College hasn't won a series from Brooklyn since 2006, the Spikes Inaugural Season.

**HOME COOKIN':** Cyclones SS Gavin Cecchini is batting .360 (18-50) at MCU Park and just .210 (13-62) on the road...As a team, Brooklyn is hitting .241 at home and has posted a 13-10 mark.

**TO INFINITY AND BIONDI:** Cyclones OF Patrick Biondi is batting .375 (12-32) over his last eight games...The former Michigan Wolverine has scored eight runs in these games as well...Biondi, who ranks fourth in the league with 15 stolen bases, has just three stolen bases in his last 24 games.

**GAVIN GOES STREAKING:** SS Gavin Cecchini has hit a hit until the sixth inning, and allowed just a single run on safely in 10 straight games...It is tied for the longest current two hits over his 6.0 innings, striking out seven as Brooklyn defeated State College 2-1 on Saturday evening...SS Gavin in the league this season...It is the 27th hitting streak in franchise history to reach 10 games and the first by a member of the 2013 Cyclones...There has been at least one hitting streak of 10 games of more in each of the 13 seasons in franchise history...The longest streak of all-time was a 17-game stretch from 1B Lucas Duda in 2007...The 19-year-old Cecchini hit just .077 (2-26) during the month of July prior to his hot stretch.

**FIRST THINGS FIRST:** OF Patrick Biondi currently has a five game hitting streak, and the 9th round selection from the University of Michigan has a hit in the first inning of each of these five games...For the season, Biondi has hit lead off in 41 of his 42 games and is batting .342 (13-38) in the first inning.

**RUNNING AT WILL:** The Cyclones have allowed a NYPL leading 96 stolen bases this season...Staten Island ranks second in the league and has allowed 68 stolen bases...The 96 stolen bases allowed in games would rank second in Major League Baseball behind only the Los Angeles Angels who have allowed 101 stolen bases in 130 games.

**JONNY ON THE SPOT:** OF Jonathan Clark currently has an eight game hitting streak and is batting .333 (11-33) during the stretch...Clark joined the Cyclones on July 26th and went 0-for-14 in four games prior to his hot streak.

**INJURY NEWS:** Cyclones LF Jared King left Tuesday night's game with an oblique injury...He is considered day-to-day and is expected to return shortly after the All-Star break.
