LAST GAME: SS Gavin Cecchini went 4-for-4 to extend his hitting streak to 15 games, but otherwise the Cyclones bat safely in 15 straight games (.419 / 26-62)...It is the longest fell silent, losing 1-0 to Vermont on Saturday evening...RHP Miller Diaz (4-3) was the hard luck loser, allowing just the single run over 6.0 innings.

VS. VERMONT: The Cyclones are 42-21 all-time against the Vermont Lake Monsters / Expos...The Cyclones went 3-0 against the Lake Monsters at MCU Park and 2-1 on the road.

DEJA VU ALL OVER AGAIN: Last night's 1-0 loss was the third time this season that Brooklyn has lost a 1-0 decision (June 30th at HV, July 30th at WPT)...The Cyclones had lost four 1-0 games since 2010 prior to the start of this season.

SHUT IT DOWN: Last night marked the seventh time this season that Brooklyn has been shut out, tied with Mahong Valley for the most in the NYPL...The seven shutouts are the most since the Cyclones were blanked seven times during the 2009 season...Brooklyn was shut out four times in 2011 and 2012 and just once in 2010.

TO INFINITY AND BIONDI: Cyclones OF Patrick Biondi is batting .333 (15-45) during the month of August and has raised his average from .219 to .247 over the period...The 9th round selection has a .426 on-base percentage during the month and has hit safely in eight consecutive home games.

RUNNING AT WILL: The Cyclones have allowed a NYPL leading 105 stolen bases this season...Staten Island ranks second in the league and has allowed 70 stolen bases...The 104 stolen bases allowed are more than any team in Major League Baseball...The Cyclones allowed just 58 stolen bases last season, while the league leader, Aberdeen, allowed just 102 all season.

GAVIN GOES STREAKING: SS Gavin Cecchini has hit current streak in the NYPL and is the third streak to reach 15 games in the league this season...It is the fourth hitting streak in franchise history to reach 15 games and the first since 1B Ike Davis hit in 15 straight contests from June 26 - July 11, 2008...The longest streak of all-time was a 17-game stretch from 1B Lucas Duda in 2007...The 19-year-old Cecchini hit just .077 (2-26) during the month of July prior to his hot stretch.

DEUCES NOT SO WILD: Including last night's game, the Cyclones have scored two runs or less in 20 of their 56 games this season.

NOT WORTH THE RISP: The Cyclones are batting just .160 (4-25) with runners in scoring position over their last four games and are batting just .224 (116-519) on the season... There are only two players on the active roster who are hitting above .300 with RISP: OF Jonathan Clark (.300 / 3-10), and OF Patrick Biondi (.308 / 12-39).

WHAT'S LEFT?: The Cyclones lead the NYPL with a .279 (143-513) average against lefthanded pitching this season... OF Jared King is batting .341 (15-44) against southpaws and C Eddie Rohan is batting .526 (10-19) against lefties.

THE ICE KING: Cyclones OF Jared King is just 1-for-22 (.045) during the month of August.

THE REAL ROB: Cyclones RHP Rob Gsellman is making just his third start at home this season, so far posting a 2.25 ERA in 12.0 IP with nine strikeouts.

- Has allowed two runs or less in six of his nine starts.
- Tossed a career-high 8.0 innings on June 30th at Hudson Valley.
- Was the second youngest Opening Day starting pitcher in franchise history at 19 years, 11 months and 1 day...RHP Gabriel Ynoa was the Opening Day starter for BKLYN in 2012 at just 19 years, 23 days.
- Made two spot starts with St. Lucie (A) of the Florida State League earlier this season, going 1-0 with a 3.00 ERA... He allowed just three runs on five hits over 9.0 innings.
- Also made five starts with Savannah (A) from May 11th - June 5th...Went 2-3 with a 3.72 ERA over 29.0 innings... Allowed two earned runs or less in three of these five outings.
- Was a two sport star at Westchester HS starring on the baseball diamond and basketball court...His team finished the 2010 basketball season ranked #3 nationally by Max Preps.
