LAST GAME: The Cyclones split a pair with Staten Island on Monday night, taking Game One by the score of 3-2, and in the first game of yesterday's doubleheader, stopping his dropping the nightcap 5-2...RHP Akeel Morris (4-0) made his hitting streak at 16 games (.409 /27-66)...It is the second first start of the season in Game One and tossed 5.0 shutout hitting streak in franchise history to reach 16 games...The frames to lower his ERA to 0.47...LF Jared King threw out Kale Sumner at the plate for the final out of the game...In Game Two, RHP Kevin McGowan (0-2) suffered the loss after allowing three runs on three hits over 3.0 innings...SS Gavin Cecchini went 0-for-3 in Game One to snap his 16-game hitting streak.

VS. STATEN ISLAND: The Cyclones are 84-78 against the Staten Island Yankees all-time, and 4-5 against the Baby Bombers this season...The Cyclones have gone 4-1 in the last five games against their cross-bridge rival...2B L.J. Mazzilli is batting .324 (11-34) in nine games against Staten Island this season...1B Alex Sanchez has a .308 (8-26) average against the Yankees.

RUNNING AT WILL: The Cyclones have allowed a NYPL leading 106 stolen bases this season...Staten Island ranks second in the league and has allowed 73 stolen bases...The 106 stolen bases allowed are more than any team in Major League Baseball and would rank 9th among all full-season Triple-A teams...The Cyclones allowed just 58 stolen bases last season, while the league leader, Aberdeen, allowed just 102 all season.

BANGED UP: LHP John Mincone (lower back) and OF Patrick Biondi (wrist) are both considered day-to-day and are not expected to be available for tonight's game.

LONG TIME NO SEE: OF Eris Peguero has rejoined the Cyclones after being transferred to Kingsport on August 14th...The OF hit .333 (6-18) in five games for the K-Mets.

WORTH THE RISP: The Cyclones went 2-for-15 with runners in scoring position during yesterday's doubleheader and are batting just .227 (125-550) on the season...There are only two players on the active roster who are hitting above .300 with RISP: OF Patrick Biondi (.310 / 13-42) and Colton Plaia (.333 / 7-21)

Daring Dario: Alvarez will look to continue his good start to the month of August on the mound tonight. Through 10.0 IP, Alvarez has posted a 0.90 ERA with 7 Strikeouts. Previously he allowed 18 ER in 32.1 IP.

- Struck out 12 batters on July 24th at Lowell...Was the first Cyclones pitcher since Collin McHugh on August 8, 2009 to strike out a dozen and only the 10th player in franchise history to reach that plateau.
- Lefthanded batters are batting just .120 (3-25) against him.
- Has limited the opposition to .205 (15-73) in four starts on the road.
- Tossed a season-high 5.0 innings on July 11th at Auburn to collect his first win since 8/6/09 with the DSL Phillies.
- Made his 2013 debut on June 23rd vs. Hudson Valley...Had not pitched in affiliated baseball since the 2009 season.
- In 2012, played in the Venezuelan Winter League for Caribes de Anzoategui.
- Also played in Panama Winter League for Diablos Rojos de Panama in 2012
- In 2011 played for Industriales de Herrera of the Panama Winter League.
- Spent the 2010 campaign with the Softbank Hawks of Japan's Pacific League.
- In his three years of work with the DSL Phillies, only surrendered one home run over 172.2 innings of work.
