LAST GAME: Brooklyn got off to a great start on Thursday night when OF **Jonathan Clark** led off the bottom of the 1st with a solo-home run, but that would be the end of the offense for the Brooklyn bats as they fell to Staten Island 7-1... RHP **John Gant** (5-3) suffered the loss after allowing two runs on six hits over his 5.0 innings of work...Clark and **Juan Gamboa**, who entered the game a combined 0-for-37, each collected two hits.

VS. VERMONT: The Cyclones are 43-21 all-time against the Vermont Lake Monsters / Expos...The Cyclones went 3-0 against the Lake Monsters at MCU Park and 2-1 on the road during the 2012 season and went 2-1 at MCU Park earlier this month.

RUNNING AT WILL: The Cyclones have allowed a NYPL leading 107 stolen bases this season...Staten Island ranks second in the league and has allowed 75 stolen bases...The 107 stolen bases allowed are more than any team in Major League Baseball and would rank 9th among all full-season Triple-A teams...The Cyclones allowed just 58 stolen bases last season, while the league leader, Aberdeen, allowed just 102 all season.

DEUCES NOT SO WILD: Including last night's game, the Cyclones have scored two runs or less in 23 of their 62 games this season...Brooklyn is 5-18 in these games.

WORTH THE RISP: The Cyclones went 6-for-34 with runners in scoring position during their series with Staten Island and are batting just .227 (129-569) on the season.

THE SNY CURSE: Over the last three seasons, the Cyclones are 2-5 when their game is broadcast on SNY, including 0-2 this year...Brooklyn has been outscored 21-42 in these games.

ROCHE INFESTATION: OF **James Roche** has hit safely in each of his last 10 games and is batting .394 (13-33) over the span...The 10 game streak is the longest active streak in the New York-Penn League and is the 28th in franchise history to reach double digits...Roche has raised his batting average from .221 to 2.51 over the span.

HOT AND COLD: OF **Jonathan Clark** started his tenure with the Cyclones by going hitless in his first four games (0-14), then had an eight game hitting streak (11-33), then went hitless in his next seven games (0-24)...Last night Clark snapped the drought with a 2-for-4 effort including his first professional home run to lead off the bottom of the first.

WHO'S HOT: SS **Gavin Cecchini** is batting .351 (27-77) during the month of August and has seven RBI in 20 games...C **Eddie Rohan** is batting .400 (8-20) with five runs scored, five doubles and one home run in six games during the month.

WHO'S NOT: 1B **Matt Oberste** is hitting .172 (11-64) with 17 strikeouts in 17 games in August...3B **Anthony Chavez** is hitting .189 (7-37) in 13 games...Chavez does not have a multi-hit game since July 18th.

STATEN ISLAND STRONG: The Cyclones pitching staff has allowed 16 home runs in 62 games this season...The Staten Island Yankees have hit seven of these 16 home runs in 12 games against the Baby Bombers.

FLIRTING WITH .500: Brooklyn has been +2 or -2 with the .500 mark every day since July 27th...The Cyclones are one of only four teams in affiliated baseball to not have a losing record in a season since the franchise started in 2001.
