LAST GAME: The Cyclones defeated the Yankees 2-1 on Thursday night at MCU Park...RHP Miller Diaz allowed just one hit over 6.0 shutout innings to collect the victory and improve to 6-3 on the year...LHP Juan Urbina recorded the most crucial out of the game, striking out Yeicok Calderon with runners on second and third with two outs in the eighth...2B Ismael Tijerina went 2-for-4 with a run scored and RBI, accounting for each of the two runs in the game.

VS. STATEN ISLAND: The Cyclones are 87-80 against Staten Island all-time and 6-7 against the Baby Bombers this season...The Yankees have not won the season series between the two clubs since 2006 when they went 9-5 against Brooklyn...Every year since, the season series has been split or Brooklyn has had the advantage, including winning the season series in 2011 and 2012.

RUNNING AT WILL: The Cyclones have allowed a NYPL leading 111 stolen bases this season...Staten Island ranks second in the league and has allowed 82 stolen bases...The 111 stolen bases allowed are more than any team in Major League Baseball...Brooklyn has allowed more stolen bases than Tri-City and Connecticut combined...The Cyclones allowed just 58 stolen bases last season.

DEUCES NOT SO WILD: Including last night's game, the Cyclones have scored two runs or less in 26 of their 69 games this season...Brooklyn is 8-18 in these games.

HOT AND COLD: OF Jonathan Clark started his tenure with the Cyclones by going hitless in his first four games (0-14), then had an eight game hitting streak (11-33), then went hitless in his next seven games (0-24)...Now, over his last five games with an at-bat, Clark is batting .296 (8-27) with nine runs scored.

GELLING LIKE GSELLMAN: RHP Rob Gsellman is the current NYPL Pitcher of the Week for the period of August 19-25...In four August starts, the All-Star righthander is 2-0 with a 1.38 ERA in four starts...He has allowed just one earned run over his last 20 innings of work.

WHO'S HOT: LF Jared King is batting .348 (8-23) with three runs scored and three RBI over his last five games...2B L.J. Mazzilli has hit safely in his last six games and is batting .346 (9-26) in these games.

NO SHOES, NO SHIRT, NO PROBLEM: 1B Matt Oberste recently made the decision to not wear an under shirt beneath his jersey...Since making the switch, the former Oklahoma Sooner is batting .364 (8-22), including a pair of three hit games...Oberste will continue to go sans undershirt in hopes of keeping his mojo going.

WHO'S NOT: C Tomas Nido is batting .130 (6-46) in 12 games during the month of August...C Colton Plaia is batting .171 (6-35) in 10 games during the month...INF Juan Gamboa has a .167 (7-42) in 11 games in August.

FLIRTING WITH .500: With one more win this season, the Cyclones will continue their streak of not having a losing season in franchise history...Brooklyn is one of only four teams in affiliated professional baseball that has finished .500 or better every year since 2001.

START ME UP: In the last seven games, Brooklyn starting pitchers have pitched to a 1.06 ERA...They have allowed just five earned runs in 42.1 innings.

- Is currently tied for first in the NYPL with a 1.60 ERA...Leads the league with a 0.92 WHIP...Opponents are batting just .206 (52-253) against him, fourth best in the league.
- Has allowed two runs or less in eight of his 11 starts.
- Struck out 13 batters on August 24th, tied for the third highest output in franchise history.
- Tossed a career-high 8.0 innings on June 30th at Hudson Valley...Matched that with 8.0 IP at VER on August 24th.
- Was the second youngest Opening Day starting pitcher in franchise history at 19 years, 11 months and 1 day...RHP Gabriel Ynoa was the Opening Day starter for BKLYN in 2012 at just 19 years, 23 days.
- Made two spot starts with St. Lucie (A) of the Florida State League earlier this season, going 1-0 with a 3.00 ERA... He allowed just three runs on five hits over 9.0 innings.
- Also made five starts with Savannah (A) from May 11th - June 5th...Went 2-3 with a 3.72 ERA over 29.0 innings... Allowed two earned runs or less in three of these five outings.
