LAST GAME: The Staten Island Yankees defeated the Brooklyn Cyclones by the score of 9-3 on Friday Night...The Baby Bombers slugged 13 hits, including two home runs...All nine runs were scored with two-outs...RHP Rob Gsellman (3-3) suffered the loss after allowing four runs, on seven hits, over 2.2 innings...Brooklyn scored three runs, only one of which came thanks to a hit.

VS. ABERDEEN: The Cyclones hold a 74-43 advantage in the all-time series against Aberdeen...The IronBirds have won five of eight meetings this season, but the team have not met since July 6th...In franchise history, the Cyclones have never lost a season series to Aberdeen.

RUNNING AT WILL: The Cyclones have allowed a NYPL leading 111 stolen bases this season...Staten Island ranks second in the league and has allowed 83 stolen bases...The 111 stolen bases allowed are more than any team in Major League Baseball...Brooklyn has allowed more stolen bases than Tri-City and Connecticut combined...The Cyclones allowed just 58 stolen bases last season.

DEUCES NOT SO WILD: Including Thursday night's game, the Cyclones have scored two runs or less in 26 of their 70 games this season...Brooklyn is 8-18 in these games.

WIN WITH PITCHING & DEFENSE: The Cyclones come into Saturday night's game with a 2.71 team ERA, second lowest in the NYPL...Brooklyn also ranks second in the NYPL with a .974 fielding percentage, just .001 behind Tri-City for the NYPL lead...Brooklyn led the New York-Penn League in both categories during the 2012 season (2.62 ERA and .977 fielding)...The Cyclones have led the league in fielding percentage in each of the last two seasons.

EVEN 'KEEL: Tonight's starter RHP Akeel Morris has struck out 11 batters over his 5.2 innings of relief against Aberdeen this season...During his minor league career, he has 192 strikeouts in 154.1 innings pitched.

BOMBS AWAY: The Cyclones rank third in the NYPL, having allowed just 20 home runs through the first 70 games of the season...Including last night's game, the Staten Island Yankees hit nine home runs in 14 games against Brooklyn...Aberdeen has allowed a league-low 12 home runs this season.

NO SHOES, NO SHIRT, NO PROBLEM: 1B Matt Oberste recently made the decision to not wear an under shirt beneath his jersey...Since making the switch, the former Oklahoma Sooner is batting .308 (8-26), including a pair of three hit games...Oberste will continue to go sans undershirt in hopes of keeping his mojo going.

AWESOME VS. ABERDEEN: In five games against the Iron Birds this season, SS Gavin Cecchini is batting .368 (7-19) and 2B L.J. Mazzilli is hitting .333 (9-27) in seven games.

WHO'S NOT: C Tomas Nido is batting .143 (7-49) in 13 games during the month of August...C Colton Plaia is batting .171 (6-35) in 10 games during the month...INF Juan Gamboa has a .167 (7-42) in 11 games in August.

FLIRTING WITH .500: With one more win this season, the Cyclones will continue their streak of not having a losing season in franchise history...Brooklyn is one of only four teams in affiliated professional baseball that has finished .500 or better every year since 2001.
