**LAST GAME:** The IronBirds defeated the Cyclones by the score of 7-0 on Saturday evening behind a stellar performance from Aberdeen ace RHP Sebastian Vader...The 21-year-old tossed 7.0 shutout frames and never allowed a runner beyond second base...For the Cyclones RHP Akeel Morris was sharp through his 5.0 innings of work, allowing just a single run on three hits while striking out seven, but the Brooklyn bats were silent all night.

**VS. ABERDEEN:** The Cyclones hold a 74-44 advantage in the all-time series against Aberdeen...The IronBirds have won five of nine meetings this season, marking the first time in franchise history that they have won the season series from the Cyclones.

**RUNNING AT WILL:** The Cyclones have allowed a NYPL leading 114 stolen bases this season...The 114 stolen bases allowed are more than any team in Major League Baseball...Brooklyn has allowed more stolen bases than Hudson Valley, Tri-City and State College combined...The Cyclones allowed just 58 stolen bases last season.

**DEUCES NOT SO WILD:** Including Saturday night's game, the Cyclones have scored two runs or less in 27 of their 71 games this season...Brooklyn is 8-19 in these games.

**WIN WITH PITCHING & DEFENSE:** The Cyclones come into Sunday night's game, leading the New York-Penn League with a .975 fielding percentage...They team has been charged with a league-low 69 errors in 2,737 chance...Brooklyn has led the league in fielding percentage in 2011 and 2012...The Cyclones also rank second in the NYPL with a 2.77 ERA, having allowed 186 earned runs in 639.1 innings of work...The Cyclones also lead the league with 636 strikeouts...Brooklyn led the league in team ERA last season

**SHUT IT DOWN:** Last night marked the eighth time this season that Brooklyn has been shut out, the second highest total in the NYPL...The eight shutouts are the highest total in franchise history, surpassing the previous mark of seven set in 2002 and matched in 2009.

**FROM HERO TO ZERO:** From August 23rd - 26th, the Cyclones scored 32 runs in four games and Brooklyn went 4-0 in these games...Over their next five games, the 'Clones have scored just nine runs and are 2-3...Brooklyn has been outscored 22-9 in these games.

**FROM ZERO TO UH-OH:** The Cyclones pitching staff has allowed 16 runs on 27 hits over their last two games...Prior to Friday night's game, Brooklyn hurlers has allowed just 14 runs in their previous seven contests.

**ROSTER ADDITION:** OF Ivan Wilson joined the Cyclones earlier today...The 18-year-old was the Mets 3rd round selection in the 2013 Draft out of Ruston HS (LA)...He appeared in 47 games with the GCL Mets this year, hitting .219 (35-160).

**PACKING 'EM IN** For the 13 consecutive season, the Cyclones will lead the NYPL in attendance...Coming into tonight's game, the team has welcomed 227,037 fans through the gates in 36 openings.

**FLIRTING WITH .500:** With one more win this season, the Cyclones will continue their streak of not having a losing season in franchise history...Brooklyn is one of only four teams in affiliated professional baseball that has finished .500 or better every year since 2001.

**PLAYOFF TIX:** Tickets for potential playoff games at MCU Park are on sale now and cost just \$10.

- Walked a season-high 6 batters in his start on 8/20, the most walks issued by a Cyclones pitcher this season.
- Struck out 12 batters on July 24th at Lowell...Was the first Cyclones pitcher since Collin McHugh on August 8, 2009 to strike out a dozen and only the 10th player in franchise history to reach that plateau.
- Lefthanded batters are batting just .171 (6-35) against him.
- Tossed a season-high 5.0 innings on July 11th at Auburn to collect his first win since 8/6/09 with the DSL Phillies.
- Made his 2013 debut on June 23rd vs. Hudson Valley...Had not pitched in affiliated baseball since the 2009 season.
