ABOUT LAST NIGHT: The Cyclones and Spinners split a doubleheader with Lowell taking Game One 3-2 and then Brooklyn returned the favor with a 3-2, extra innings win in Game Two...LHP **Kelly Secrest** (3-0) got the win after tossing 2.2 scoreless frames...3B **Jhoan Ureña** plated the winning run in the nightcap with a walk-off RBI single in the bottom of the 8th...RHP **Martires Arias** had his scoreless streak snapped at 24.0 IP.

VS. LOWELL: The Cyclones are 43-28 against Lowell, including 4-1 this year...Since 2010, Brooklyn is 19-9 against the Spinners with the Cyclones winning the season series every season except 2012.

EXTRA INNINGS: Last night's extra innings contest was the eighth game this season to need extra frames...The eight extra inning games are tied for second in the NYPL behind Jamestown who has played 10 extra innings games...Brooklyn is 3-5 in extra innings games this year and 99-70 all-time.

IRÓN MAÑ: Cyclones 3B **Jhoan Ureña** is the only player in the New York-Penn League to participate in all 59 games this season...The franchise record for most games in a single season is 74, set by OF **Kirk Niewenhuis** (2008), OF **Caleb Stewart** (2003) and 1B **Ian Bladergroen** (2005).

ONE AND WON: Both games of yesterday's doubleheader were decided by one run...For the Cyclones, they have now played in three consecutive one-run games and in 19 one run games this season, tied for third most in the NYPL...Brooklyn is 9-10 in one run contests...Staten Island has played 21 one-run games and Tri-City has played in 20 one-run games.

TRIPLE DOUBLE: Cyclones 3B **Jhoan Ureña** has hit safely in each of his last nine games, and is batting .378 (14-37) over the span...The 19-year-old already has a pair of 13-game hitting streaks this season and is only the second player in franchise history to have multiple hit streaks of 10 or more games in a single season...With a hit this evening, he would become the only player in franchise history to have three, double digit hitting streaks in the same season.

RUN AND WON: When OF **Michael Conforto** scores a run, the Cyclones are 10-2...The first round pick in the 2014 MLB Draft has scored 16 runs in 25 games with Brooklyn this season.

LOOKING ROSEY: SS **Amed Rosario** has hit safely in 21 of his last 26 games dating to July 16th...The 18-year-old, who is the fourth youngest player in the NYPL, is batting .315 (35-111) over this span and leads the NYPL with 35 hits over this span...He has raised his batting average from .260 to .288 during the course of this streak...For the season, Rosario is second in the NYPL with 59 hits, and is tied for the league lead with five triples.

NOBODY'S HOME: Cyclones C **Tomas Nido** is batting .333 (13-39) leading off an inning and .296 (24-81) with nobody on base...His numbers drop to .232 (16-69) with runners on and .244 (11-45) with RISP.

LEAVING THE YARD: Brooklyn pitchers have allowed a league-low 16 home runs in 519.1 IP this season...Brooklyn has allowed just one home run in 12 games during the month of August...Similarly, Brooklyn batters have a league-low 17 home runs...They are tied with Mahoning Valley for fewest home runs in the NYPL.
