ABOUT LAST NIGHT: Brooklyn jumped out to a 7-0 lead after the third inning and never looked back as they defeated the Tri-City ValleyCats on Friday Night at MCU Park...3B **Jhoan Ureña** went 3-for-5 with two runs scored and an RBI while 2B **Tyler Moore** added a two-RBI effort...RHP **Martires Arias** struggled through 5.0 innings, walking six batters, but did not allow a run and improved to 2-0.

VS. TRI-CITY: The Cyclones are 35-23 all-time against the Tri-City ValleyCats...The teams split the series 3-3 during the 2013 season with Brooklyn going 2-1 at MCU Park and Tri-City returning the favor at Bruno Stadium.

IRÓN MAÑ: Cyclones 3B **Jhoan Ureña** is the only player in the New York-Penn League to participate in all 66 games this season...The franchise record for most games in a single season is 74, set by OF **Kirk Niewenhuis** (2008), OF **Caleb Stewart** (2003) and 1B **Ian Bladergroen** (2005).

RUN AND WON: When OF **Michael Conforto** scores a run, the Cyclones are 15-2...The first round pick has scored 23 runs in 32 games with Brooklyn this season...Since joining the Cyclones on July 19th, he has never gone more than two games without a base-hit and Brooklyn is 22-10 in these games....The 21-year-old is batting .367 (22-60) in 17 games at MCU Park.

GO 'MAS: Cyclones C **Tomas Nido** currently has an 11-game hitting streak and is batting .400 (16-40) over this stretch...The 20-year-old is hitting .339 (19-56) during the month of August...Nido's streak is the sixth to reach double digits by the Cyclones this season and the 34th all-time in Cyclones franchise history.

SHUT IT DOWN: With last night's 7-0 victory, was the 10th shutout of the season for Brooklyn pitchers, tops in the New York-Penn League...It's the sixth time in team history that they have had double digit shutouts in a season...The franchise record for shutouts in a season is 11, set in 2003.

PITCHING GREAT IN MONTH EIGHT: The Cyclones are 13-6 during the month of August with a 1.45 ERA...The team has allowed just 27 earned runs (23 unearned runs) in 168.0 innings...The opposition is batting just .217 (136-628) during the month.

LEAVING THE YARD: Brooklyn pitchers have allowed a league-low 16 home runs in 581.1 IP this season... Brooklyn has allowed just one home run in 19 games during the month of August...Offensively, the Cyclones are tied for 12th in the league with 20 home runs hit.

THE DEFENSE RESTS: Brooklyn currently leads the league with 100 errors this season...The 100 miscues are the most since the team had a franchise record 108 errors in 2006...Brooklyn committed just 74 errors last year, and 67 errors in 2012.

MOORE OF THE SAME: Cyclones INF **Tyler Moore** has hit safely in five straight games and is batting .533 (8-15) over the stretch with three multi-hit games.

LAND OF OZ: RHP **Corey Oswalt** is 5-0 with a 1.77 ERA in eight games at MCU Park this season.

EVEN STEVEN...I MEAN JHOAN: Switch-hitting INF **Jhoan Ureña** is batting .295 (13-44) against LHP and .295 (61-207) against RHP.
