ABOUT LAST NIGHT: The Cyclones rallied from a tough loss the night prior to defeat the Staten Island Yankees 8-2 at RCBB...RHP **Casey Meisner** (4-3) tossed 6.0 strong innings, allowing just one run on four hits while striking out a career-high 11 batters...SS **Amed Rosario** returned to the lineup and went 3-for-5 with two RBI.

VS. STATEN ISLAND: The Cyclones are 5-6 against the Staten Island Yankees this season and are 92-87 against them all-time...Brooklyn is 3-2 against SI at home.

HEATING UP: Since the Cyclones were 15-19 and a season-low four games under .500 on July 18th, the Cyclones have gone 24-12 and outscored the opposition 166-114 despite having two losses by 10 or more runs.

CASEY ON THE MOUND: RHP **Casey Meisner** established a career-high with 11 strikeouts last night and now ranks second in the NYPL with 64 strikeouts...Since July 29th, the 19-year-old is 4-0 with a 1.76 ERA in five starts... In 30.2 innings he has allowed just nine runs, six earned.

RUN AND WON: When OF **Michael Conforto** scores a run, the Cyclones are 17-2...The first round pick has scored 26 runs in 36 games with Brooklyn this season...Since joining the Cyclones on July 19th, he has never gone more than two games without a base-hit and Brooklyn is 24-12 in these games.

GETTING CONFORTO-BLE: OF **Michael Conforto** collected his 15th multi-hit game of the season last night and his fourth in his last six games...The former Oregon State Beaver is batting .348 (24-69) at MCU Park and just .270 (17-63) on the road...He has a .380 batting average when he puts the ball in play.

BERNING UP: Cyclones OF Michael Bernal has hit safely in six straight games, his longest stretch of the season...The All-Star rightfielder is batting .429 (9-21) over this span and is batting .643 (9-14) when he makes contact...Bernal ranks third in the NYPL with 86 punchouts this season

PITCHING GREAT IN MONTH EIGHT: The Cyclones are 15-8 during the month of August with a 1.58 ERA, lowest in the NYPL...Hudson Valley ranks second in the league with a 2.51 ERA for the month...The 'Clones have allowed just 36 earned runs in 204.2 innings.

THE DEFENSE RESTS: Brooklyn currently leads the league with 104 errors this season...The 104 miscues are the most since the team had a franchise record 108 errors in 2006...Brooklyn committed just 74 errors last year, and 67 errors in 2012.

PLAYOFF PICTURE: The Cyclones currently lead the NYPL Wild Card race by 2.0 games over Connecticut and 3.5 games over the Staten Island Yankees and Lowell Spinners...Staten Island and Lowell will play one game less than both the Tigers and Cyclones since they had a game cancelled due to rain.

BROOKLYN BOLTS: The newly-established FXFL has formally announced that MCU Park will play host to one of their franchises for the Inaugural season...The Brooklyn Bolts will be joined by the Florida Blacktips (Florida International Univ.), Omaha Mammoths (TD Ameritrade Park) and a Boston franchise to be named at a later date...The league will serve as a developmental league for players, coaches and referees looking to advance to the NFL...The season will begin in mid-October.

- Got the win in his first start at State College (July 9th)...Tossed 5.0 shutout innings, allowing just five hits to the league's top offensive club.
- Struck out a season-high seven batters over 5.0 innings on August 13th vs. Lowell.
- Made his 2014 debut on June 17th with 3.0 shutout innings vs. Hudson Valley.
- Has allowed just one extra-base hit to righthanded batters all season (64 at-bats)
