ABOUT LAST NIGHT: The Cyclones defensive struggles continued on Thursday night as they committed five errors, including two in the ninth inning as they lost to Tri-City 4-3...3B **Jhoan Urena** went 2-for-4 with an RBI and RHP **Martires Arias** struck out seven over his 5.0 innings of work, but did not factor in the decision.

VS. TRI-CITY: The Cyclones are 36-25 all-time against the Tri-City ValleyCats...The teams split the series 3-3 during the 2013 season...Last weekend, Brooklyn took two of three from the 'Cats.

HEATING UP: Since the Cyclones were 15-19 and a season-low four games under .500 on July 18th, the Cyclones have gone 25-13 and outscored the opposition 172-120 despite having two losses by 10 or more runs.

RUN AND WON: When OF **Michael Conforto** scores a run, the Cyclones are 18-2...The first round pick has scored 27 runs in 38 games with Brooklyn this season...Since joining the Cyclones on July 19th, he has never gone more than two games without a base-hit and Brooklyn is 25-13 in these games.

GETTING CONFORTO-BLE: OF **Michael Conforto** collected has four multi-hit games in his last five starts and is batting .480 (12-25) over this stretch...Since making his pro debut on July 19th, Conforto is tied for the NYPL lead with 49 hits and ranks second with 64 total bases.

CYCLONES ELEVEN: Over their last 11 games, the Cyclones are batting .290 (115-396) and have scored 46 runs while allowing just 17 earned runs over this span.

THE DEFENSE RESTS: After last night's game, the Cyclones had one of their six errors changed to a base hit, giving them five errors on the game...It marked the fifth time this season that the team has had at least five errors in a game...Prior to this season, the Cyclones had not committed five errors in a game since August 10, 2010 at Connecticut...The 110 errors on the season for the Cyclones are a franchise-record, topping the mark of 108 set in 2006...The Cyclones were guilty of just 74 errors in 2013 and 67 errors in 2012...3B Jhoan Urena is tied for the lead among all NYPL third baseman with 17 errors this year.

PITCHING GREAT IN MONTH EIGHT: The Cyclones are 16-9 during the month of August with a 1.61 ERA, lowest in the NYPL...Staten Island ranks second in the league with a 2.43 ERA for the month...The 'Clones have allowed just 40 earned runs in 223.2 innings.

IRON MAN: Cyclones 3B Jhoan Urena leads the NYPL with 71 games played this season...The only game he has missed all year is when he was ejected prior to the first pitch at Staten Island on August 25th...The franchise record for most games in a single season is 74, set by OF **Kirk Niewenhuis** (2008), OF **Caleb Stewart** (2003) and 1B **Ian Bladergroen** (2005).

PLAYOFF PICTURE: The Cyclones currently lead the NYPL Wild Card race by 2.0 games over Connecticut and 3.5 games over the Staten Island Yankees and Lowell Spinners with four games remaining...With one more Cyclones victory or Spinners / Yankees loss those teams will be eliminated...Brooklyn's magic number to clinch a playoff spot is three.
