ABOUT LAST NIGHT: The Cyclones lost their third straight one-run game as the ValleyCats completed a three-game sweep thanks to a 3-2 win at Bruno Stadium...RHP **Marcos Molina** (7-3) was tagged with the loss after allowing three runs over 7.0 innings while striking out 10...SS **Amed Rosario** went 3-for-4 in a losing effort.

VS. STATEN ISLAND: The Cyclones are 6-6 against the Staten Island Yankees this season and are 93-87 against them all-time...Brooklyn is 4-2 against SI at home.

BOTTOMS UP: In last night's loss at Tri-City, the bottom of the order - numbers five through nine - combined to go 0-for-18...On Friday night, they went 2-for-17, meaning that in their last two games those spots in the batting order are hitting .057 (2-35)...INF **Anthony Chavez** is the only batter with hits over this span, everyone else who has hit in those spots is 0-for-33.

STRANDED: During their three-game series against the ValleyCats, Brooklyn left 24 runners on base and hit .235 (8-34) with Runners in Scoring Position...Over their last six games, the Cyclones have left 55 runners on base

GETTING CONFORTO-BLE: OF **Michael Conforto** collected has hit safely in seven straight games and is batting .424 (14-33) in these games...The former Oregon State Beaver is batting .378 (28-74) at MCU Park and .284 (23-81) on the road...The Cyclones are 18-3 when he scores a run.

FEELING ROSEY: SS **Amed Rosario** collected seven hits in the three-game series against Tri-City, hitting .538 (7-13)...The rest of the Brooklyn offense hit just .193 (17-88) during the series.

THE DEFENSE RESTS: The Cyclones currently lead the NYPL with 113 errors on the season, including eight during their most recent three-game series in Tri-City...Prior to this season, the Cyclones had not committed five errors in a game since August 10, 2010 at Connecticut, they have done so on five occasions this season...The 113 errors on the season for the Cyclones are a franchise-record, topping the mark of 108 set in 2006...The Cyclones were guilty of just 74 errors in 2013 and 67 errors in 2012.

IRON MAN: Cyclones 3B Jhoan Ureña leads the NYPL with 73 games played this season...The only game he has missed all year is when he was ejected prior to the first pitch at Staten Island on August 25th...The franchise record for most games in a single season is 74, set by OF **Kirk Niewenhuis** (2008), OF **Caleb Stewart** (2003) and 1B **Ian Bladergroen** (2005).

PLAYOFF PICTURE: The Cyclones and Tigers are currently tied for the final spot in the New York-Penn League playoffs with just two games remaining...Connecticut holds the tie-breaker over the Cyclones having gone 4-2 against them this season...Lowell and Staten Island were officially eliminated from contention last night with losses.

TRIPLE CROWN: Cyclones RHP **Marcos Molina** will finish the season tied for the NYPL lead with seven wins, will lead the NYPL in ERA (1.77) and will be tops with 91 strikeouts...It marks the first time in franchise history that a pitcher has led all three major statistical categories.
