ABOUT LAST NIGHT: The Cyclones dropped the opening game of a three-game set with the Mahoning Valley Scrappers on Wednesday night in a game that went 12-innings by the score of 2-1...RHP **Luis Rengel** (0-1) was tagged with his first loss of the year...Brooklyn starte, RHP **Scarlyn Reyes** had another strong outing, tossing 6.0 innings of shutout baseball.

SOMETHING IN THE ARIAS: After making 8 appearances, and three starts with the Kingsport Mets, Martires Arias is making his first start with the Brooklyn Cyclones. With Kingsport, Arias was 4-0, with two saves and a 0.50 ERA.

VS. MAHONING VALLEY: The Cyclones are 24-18 all-time against the Scrappers including going 2-1 against Mahoning Valley in 2012, the last time the team visited Eastwood Field...Last year, the Scrappers returned the favor taking two of three in Brooklyn...The Cyclones and Scrappers met in the first home game in franchise history on June 25, 2001...Brooklyn won 3-2 in extra innings.

IRÓN MAÑ: Cyclones 3B **Jhoan Ureña** is the only player in the New York-Penn League to participate in all 52 games this season...There are four players in franchise history who have appeared in 74 games in a single season, the franchise record, including OF **Kirk Niewenhuis**, OF **Caleb Stewart** and 1B **Ian Bladergroen**.

CURRENT 'CLONES : The Cyclones are 12-6 since July 19th, the date that OF **Michael Conforto** made his pro debut...Over these 18 games, the Cyclones are batting .268 (163-606) with 91 runs scored (5.0 per game)...Prior to this stretch, the team was batting .230 (255-1108) and averaging 3.4 runs per game...Brooklyn is 7-3

in their last 10 games, the second-best record in the New York-Penn League over that span.

LOOKING ROSEY : SS **Amed Rosario** has nine multi-hit games in his last 18 starts dating to July 17th...The 18-year-old has raised his batting average from .260 to .294 over this stretch...He is batting .337 (28-83) in these games...His 28 hits are the most in the NYPL over this span...His four triples over this span are also the most in the NYPL.

SWEET SIX-CESS: The Cyclones have scored six runs or more in 10 of their last 20 games after having scored six times on only five occasions during the team's first 32 games of the season.

DOUBLE TROUBLE: Cyclones OF **Tucker Tharp** has grounded into a league-high six double plays this season...As a team, Brooklyn has hit into 32 double plays sixth fewest in the NYPL.

TO 'ERR IS HUMAN: The Cyclones are currently tied for the worst fielding percentage (.961) in the NYPL this season, and lead the league with 77 errors.

RUNNING AT WILL: Cyclones catchers had thrown out 22 of 87 base stealers for a .253 percentage...The 65 stolen bases are the third most in the league behind Staten Island and Aberdeen who have each allowed 68 swipes.

STRIKEOUTS: After Wednesday's game, in which Brooklyn struck out 10 times, the Cyclones are now tied for the most strikeouts in the NYPL with 452 strikeouts this season.
