**ABOUT LAST NIGHT:** The Cyclones took the series opener from the State College Spikes on Wednesday evening, winning by the score of 4-0...The teams combined to go 2-for-22 with RISP...RHP **Scarlyn Reyes** (1-1) got the win after tossing 5.0 shutout frames in his first start of the year...OF **Joe Tuschak** went 2-for-4 with two RBI, including a solo home run and OF **Michael Bernal** added a two-RBI effort.

**VS. STATE COLLEGE:** The Cyclones are 19-6 all-time against the State College Spikes...Brooklyn is 11-2 in games played at MFLP and have outscored the Spikes 73-39 in these games...The Cyclones last played in University Park, PA in 2012, sweeping a three game set.

**SHUT IT DOWN:** With their 4-0 win last night, the Cyclones collected their fifth shutout win of the season, which is tied for the NYPL lead with the Hudson Valley Renegades...The Cyclones and Renegades are the only teams in the league with more than two shutouts...For State College, it marked the first time this season that they have been kept off the scoreboard.

**JUST KEEP K'ING:** Cyclones batters are currently leading the NYPL with 249 strikeouts this season through 26 games...The Cyclones have 12 games this season with 10 or more strikeouts, including five of their last 11 games.

**RUN AT YOUR OWN RISK:** Last night, OF **Michael Bernal** threw out C Brian O'Keefe at second base for his fourth outfield assist of the season...The four assists are tied with Jamestown's Jordan Luplow for tops among all outfielders in the NYPL.

**IRON MEN:** Cyclones 3B **Jhoan Ureña** and OF **Michael Bernal** are the only players in the NYPL who have played in each of 26 games this season for their team... Five other players have appeared in 25 contests, including SS **Amed Rosario**.

**ROAD SWEET ROAD?:** As a team, the Cyclones are batting .238 (90-378) in 11 road games...OF **Michael Bernal** is batting .325 (13-40) on the road and just .146 (7-48) at MCU Park...SS **Amed Rosario** is batting .351 (13-37) on the road and .227 (10-44) on the road.

**THE "K" IN MIKE:** Cyclones OF **Michael Bernal** leads the NYPL with 37 strikeouts...The 22-year-old has at least one strikeout in 22 of his 26 games this season, and has 15 strikeouts in 30 at-bats during the month of July.

**PACKING A PUNCH:** Brooklyn has hit seven home runs in 11 road games this season...Conversely, the team has just three home runs in 15 games at MCU Park this season.

**THE DEFENSE RESTS:** The Cyclones are currently 10th in the NYPL with a .963 fielding percentage and have committed 36 errors in 26 games...The Cyclones did not commit an error in yesterday's game, marking the first time this season that Brooklyn has strung together three consecutive errorless games.

**NOT SO HOT:** 2B **Anthony Chavez** is hitless in his last 21 at-bats dating to June 18th, and has 13 strikeouts in these 21 AB's.

**HOLD ON:** Through the first 25 games of the season, Brooklyn had two bullpen holds, last night they had 3.
