ABOUT LAST NIGHT: The Cyclones bats were silent most of the night, managing just two hits, as State College took the middle game of a three-game set by the score of 4-1 on Thursday evening...**C Tyler Moore** and DH **Tomas Nido** were the lone Cyclones with hits, and Nido also had the lone RBI...RHP **Casey Meisner** (0-2) was tagged with the loss after allowing three runs, earned, on six hits over 4.2 innings.

VS. STATE COLLEGE: The Cyclones are 19-7 all-time against the State College Spikes...Brooklyn is 11-3 in games played at MFLP and have outscored the Spikes 74-43 in these games.

JUST KEEP K'ING: Cyclones batters are currently leading the NYPL with 261 strikeouts this season through 27 games...The Cyclones have 13 games this season with 10 or more strikeouts, including six of their last 12 games.

RUN AT YOUR OWN RISK: Wednesday night, OF **Michael Bernal** threw out C Brian O'Keefe at second base for his fourth outfield assist of the season...The four assists are tied with Jamestown's Jordan Luplow for tops among all outfielders in the NYPL.

IRON MEN: Cyclones 3B **Jhoan Ureña** and OF **Michael Bernal** are the only players in the NYPL who have played in each of 27 games this season for their team... Five other players have appeared in 26 contests, including SS **Amed Rosario**.

ANTH-Ofer-NY: 2B **Anthony Chavez** is hitless in his last 21 at-bats dating to June 18th, and has 13 strikeouts in these 21 AB's.

ALRIGHT VS. LEFT: As a team, the Cyclones are batting .308 (37-120) against lefthanded pitching this season...OF **Michael Katz** is batting .417 (5-12) against LHP and OF **Tucker Tharp** is hitting .357 (5-14) against southpaws...Brooklyn has 29 k's in 120 at-bats (24.1%) against lefties and 232 strikeouts in 741 at-bats (31.3%) against righthanded pitchers.

MOORE ROAD GAMES: Cyclones C **Tyler Moore** has hit safely in each of his last seven road games and is batting .350 (7-20) over this span...Despite hitting safely in 16 of his 22 starts this season, he only has one multi-hit game. (June 25th vs. Aberdeen).

PACKING A PUNCH: Brooklyn has hit seven home runs in 12 road games this season...Conversely, the team has just three home runs in 15 games at MCU Park this season.

THE "K" IN MIKE: Cyclones OF **Michael Bernal** leads the NYPL with 39 strikeouts...The 22-year-old has at least one strikeout in 23 of his 26 games with an at-bat this season, and has 17 strikeouts in 33 at-bats during the month of July...The outfielder has at least one strikeout in his last eight games, and in 14 of his last 15 starts... The 22-year-old has a .385 (20-52) batting average when he puts the ball in play, including a .462 (6-13) average against lefthanders.

THE DEFENSE RESTS: The Cyclones are currently 10th in the NYPL with a .963 fielding percentage and have committed 38 errors in 27 games...19 of the 38 errors have been committed by the second baseman or short-stop.
