ABOUT LAST NIGHT: The Cyclones and Tigers had their game called in the top of the sixth with the tying run at the plate due to fog on Monday evening...Connecticut won 2-0 to complete the three-game sweep...RHP Marcos Molina (2-1) had his 19.0 inning scoreless streak snapped when he allowed a run in the first inning.

VS. JAMESTOWN: The Cyclones are 22-17 all-time against the Jammers...The Cyclones went 2-1 against Jamestown in 2013...The Cyclones and Jammers met in the first game in franchise history on June 19, 2001.

RECENT CYCLONES: After starting the season 11-4, the team has gone 4-12 since June 28th and have been outscored 78-47 in these games.

JUST KEEP K'ING: Cyclones batters are currently leading the NYPL with 288 strikeouts this season in 980 team at-bats (29.4%)...The Cyclones have 13 games this season with 10 or more strikeouts.

IRON MAN: Cyclones 3B **Jhoan Ureña** is the only player in the NYPL that has appeared in 31 games this season...Five players in the league have appeared in 30 games, including three Cyclones: OF **Michael Bernal**, OF/1B **Michael Katz** and SS **Amed Rosario**.

THE FROST OF JULY: The Cyclones are 4-10 during the month of July and have been outscored 62-38 in the 14 games...Brooklyn has scored three runs or less in 10 of 14 contests during the month.

ZERO TO HERO: The Cyclones are currently tied for the NYPL lead with five shutout wins...They are also tied for the league lead with four shutout losses.

STARTING TO PURR: OF **Michal Katz** is batting .371 (13-35) over his last 10 games...The Mets 9th round selection in the 2014 MLB Draft has five multi-hit games in these 10 starts.

THE CURSE OF SNY: Tomorrow's game will mark the first of two games televised on SNY this season...Over the past three years, the team is 2-5 in games on SNY and have been outscored 42-21 in these contests.

THE "K" IN MIKE: Cyclones OF **Michael Bernal** leads the NYPL with 46 strikeouts...The 22-year-old has at least one strikeout in 26 of his 29 games with an at-bat this season, and has 24 strikeouts in 43 at-bats during the month of July...The outfielder has at least one strikeout in his last 11 games, and in 17 of his last 18 starts...The 22-year-old has a .400 (22-55) batting average when he puts the ball in play...Bernal has 14 games with multiple strikeouts this season.

TRANSACTION: RHP **Luis Rengel** was added to the Cyclones roster prior to Sunday's game...The native of Venezuela was transferred from Kingsport and made his Cyclones debut with 1.1 innings of scoreless relief.

MICHAEL CONFORTO: On Friday, the Mets came to terms with OF **Michael Conforto**, their first round selection in the 2014 MLB Draft...The former Oregon State Beaver joined the Cyclones on Saturday, but has not been added to the active roster...Conforto is expected to make his first appearance with the Cyclones after flying to Los Angeles on Thursday for the "Golden Spikes Award," given annually to the country's top amateur player.
