**ABOUT LAST NIGHT:** The Cyclones snapped an eight-game losing streak with a 8-4 victory over the Williamsport Crosscutters on Saturday night...RHP **Octavio Acosta** (3-1) tossed 8.0 impressive innings, allowing just one unearned run on four hits while striking out seven...C **Adrian Abreu** went 2-for-5 with a three-run home run to pace the Cyclones offense.

**VS. WILLIAMSPORT:** The Cyclones are 38-27 all-time against the Crosscutters...Brooklyn went 1-2 in Williamsport last season with the Cyclones taking two-of-three when the teams last met in Brooklyn during 2012.

**RECENT CYCLONES:** After starting the season 11-4, the team has gone 5-15 since June 28th and have been outscored 107-70 in these games.

**LOSING STREAK:** The Cyclones snapped their eight game losing streak, the second longest in franchise history, with the win last night...Brooklyn lost a franchise-worst nine games in 2002 (8/26 - 9/02).

**JUST KEEP K'ING:** Cyclones batters are currently leading the NYPL with 322 strikeouts this season in 1,142 team at-bats (27.2 %)...The Cyclones have 15 games this season with 10 or more strikeouts, however they only struck out four times last night, a season-low for a nine inning game.

**THE FROST OF JULY:** The Cyclones are 5-13 during the month of July and have been outscored 91-61 in the 18 games...Brooklyn has scored three runs or less in 11 of 18 contests during the month...Cyclones pitchers have allowed 152 base hits in 154.2 innings during the month, as well as 59 base-on-balls.

**TOP SHELF:** OF **Michael Conorto**, selected 10th overall in the 2014 MLB Draft, is the highest drafted player to suit up for Brooklyn in franchise history...Previously, SS **Gavin Cecchini** (12th overall in 2012) held the mark...He becomes the eight first round pick to play for the team since 2001.

**THE 500 CLUB:** The Cyclones are currently three games under .500...The team has never been more than seven games under .500 (0-7, in 2006)...Brooklyn is one of four pro franchises to finish .500 or better ever year since '01.

**DEEP FREEZE:** Cyclones OF **Tucker Tharp** snapped an 0-for-16 slump with a single in his final at-bat last night and is hitting .118 (4-34) since July 8th...C **Tyler Moore** is 2-for-22 over his last seven games and is batting just .125 (6-for-48) during July.

**WALKING WOUNDED:** Cyclones OF **Joe Tuschak** and 1B/OF **Jeff Diehl** were both late scratches from last night's game...Tuschak is nursing a left hamstring injury and Diehl is coping with an oblique injury.

**SUPER HEROES:** Prior to tonight's game, MCU Park will host a Zumba for Life event to raise money for the American Cancer Society as part of "Super Hero" day...The team will also honor cancer survivors and caregivers, including 10-year-old Alexiana Abernovich from Mill Basin who is a cancer survivor.

**TRANSACTION:** Prior to tonight's game, LHP **Paul Paez** was added to the Cyclones roster from Savannah (A)...The lefthander was 0-2 with a 5.87 ERA in 16 games with the Sand Gnats...The southpaw spent the majority of the 2013 season with the Cyclones.

- Missed the majority of the 2013 season with a lateral miniscus tear in his right knee... Did not pitch after July 10, 2013
- Made two starts with the K-Mets prior to his injury, going 0-1 with a 4.00 ERA
- Was 3-2 in six starts with Kingsport in 2012...Had two rough outings in which he allowed a combined 13 earned runs, but allowed just nine earned runs over his other four starts.
