ABOUT LAST NIGHT: The Cyclones took their second straight from Williamsport, winning on Sunday night by the score of 6-0...RHP Corey Oswalt (3-1) and RHP Scarlyn Reyes combined on a two-hitter...3B Jhoan Ureña went 2-for-5 with a run scored, a double and two RBI to pace the Brooklyn bats.

VS. WILLIAMSPORT: The Cyclones are 39-27 all-time against the Crosscutters...Brooklyn went 1-2 in Williamsport last season with the Cyclones taking two-of-three when the teams last met in Brooklyn during 2012.

RECENT CYCLONES: After starting the season 11-4, the team has gone 6-15 since June 28th and have been outscored 107-76 in these games.

SHUT IT DOWN: Last night marked the league-leading sixth shutout of the season for Brooklyn pitchers...The Cyclones are tied with the Hudson Valley Renegades with six shutouts...The team has also been shutout four times, which is also the most in hte NYPL

JUST KEEP K'ING: Cyclones batters are currently leading the NYPL with 330 strikeouts this season in 1,179 team at-bats (27.9 %)...The Cyclones have 15 games this season with 10 or more strikeouts...OF Michael Bernal leads the New York-Penn League with 52 strikeouts including at least one in each of his last 16 games.

THE FROST OF JULY: The Cyclones are 6-13 during the month of July and have been outscored 91-67 in the 19 games...Brooklyn has scored three runs or less in 11 of 19 contests during the month...Cyclones pitchers have allowed 154 base hits in 163.2 innings during the month, as well as 59 base-on-balls.

A RUN ON RUNS: The Cyclones have score six runs or more in each of their last four games after having scored six times on only five occasions during the team's first 32 games of the season.

THE 500 CLUB: The Cyclones are currently two games under .500...The team has never been more than seven games under .500 (0-7, in 2006)...Brooklyn is one of four pro franchises to finish .500 or better ever year since '01.

JHO' DA MAN: Cyclones 3B Jhoan Ureña currently has a six game hitting streak in which he is batting .345 (10-29)...Earlier this season, the 19-year-old had a 13-game hitting streak, which was the longest by a teenager in franchise history...Ureña, who is currently batting .307 is looking to become the first teenager since 2002 to hit .300 in a season for the Cyclones.

LOOKING ROSEY: Cyclones SS Amed Rosario has hit safely in five straight contests, one short of his season-high six game streak from June 22nd-June 27th...The 18-year-old is batting .320 (8-25) over his current streak.

WALKING WOUNDED: Cyclones OF Joe Tuschak and 1B/OF Jeff Diehl were both late scratches from last night's game...Tuschak is nursing a left hamstring injury and Diehl is coping with an oblique injury.

TRANSACTION: Prior to yesterday's game, LHP Paul Paez was added to the Cyclones roster from Savannah (A)...The lefthander was 0-2 with a 5.87 ERA in 16 games with the Sand Gnats...The southpaw spent the majority of the 2013 season with the Cyclones.
