**ABOUT LAST NIGHT:** The Cyclones completed a three-game sweep of the Crosscutters with a 5-2 win at MCU Park...RHP **Marcos Molina** (3-1) tossed 7.0 solid innings, striking out eight while allowing two runs, earned...Offensively, 1B **Michael Katz** went 4-for-4 with a pair of RBI to pace the Brooklyn bats.

**VS. ABERDEEN:** The Cyclones are 80-47 all-time against the IronBirds...They are 6-2 against Aberdeen this season including 3-0 at Ripken Stadium...C **Tyler Moore** is batting .333 (5-15) against Aberdeen and OF **Tucker Tharp** is batting .365 (12-33) in eight games against the 'Birds.

**RECENT CYCLONES:** The team has scored 32 runs in their last five games...Prior to this stretch, the team had scored 32 runs in their previous 13 games dating to July to July 5th...Brooklyn is batting .280 (56-200) over the last five games.

**JUST KEEP K'ING:** Cyclones batters are currently leading the NYPL with 338 strikeouts this season in 1,212 team at-bats (27.9 %)...The Cyclones have 15 games this season with 10 or more strikeouts...OF **Michael Bernal** leads the New York-Penn League with 54 strikeouts including at least one in each of his last 17 games.

**THE FROST OF JULY:** The Cyclones are 7-13 during the month of July and have been outscored 93-72 in the 20 games...Brooklyn has scored three runs or less in 11 of 20 contests during the month.

**THE 500 CLUB:** The Cyclones are currently two games under .500...The team has never been more than seven games under .500 (0-7, in 2006)...Brooklyn is one of four pro franchises to finish .500 or better ever year since '01.

**TATTOO'ING TARPLEY:** Tonight will mark the third time this season that the Cyclones have faced LHP **Stephen Tarpley**...He has a 5.40 ERA (five ER / 8.1 IP) and Brooklyn is batting .342 (13-38) against him.

**JHO' DA MAN:** Cyclones 3B **Jhoan Ureña** currently has a seven game hitting streak in which he is batting .333 (11-33)...Earlier this season, the 19-year-old had a 13-game hitting streak, which was the longest by a teenager in franchise history...Ureña, who is currently batting .305 is looking to become the first teenager since 2002 to hit .300 in a season for the Cyclones.

**LOOKING ROSEY:** Cyclones SS **Amed Rosario** has hit safely in six straight contests, tying his season-high six game streak from June 22nd-June 27th...The 18-year-old is batting .357 (10-28) over his current streak.

**PITCHING IN:** Cyclones pitching coach **Tom Signore** continues to deal with Post-Concussion Syndrome after being hit in the head with a pitch on May 4th while working in Las Vegas (AAA)...He is expected to be sidelined for an additional 1-2 weeks...**Dave LaRoche**, who worked with the team in extended spring training, will fill in for Signore starting this evening in Aberdeen.

**MULTIPLE MEOWS:** Cyclones 1B **Michael Katz** had a career-high four hits on Monday afternoon...It was his third straight multi-hit game, and has raised his average from .270 to .306 over this span.

**FEELING A CHILL:** Cyclones OF **Tucker Tharp** is batting .125 (5-40) since July 8th...C **Tyler Moore** is batting .143 (8-56) during the month of July and hasn't had a multi-hit game since June 25th vs. Aberdeen.
