**ABOUT LAST NIGHT:** The Cyclones jumped out to a 3-0 lead and never looked back taking the series opener from Vermont by the score of 7-2...RHP **Scarlyn Reyes** (2-1) got the win after tossing 5.0 strong innings in a spot start...OF **Michael Bernal** went 2-for-4 with two runs scored and a solo home run to pace the Brooklyn offense.

**VS. VERMONT:** The Cyclones are 47-21 all-time against the Vermont Lake Monsters / Expos...The Cyclones went 5-1 against the Lake Monsters last season, including a 2-1 mark at MCU Park.

**RECENT CYCLONES:** The team has scored 47 runs in their last eight games, and has scored six runs or more in six of these eight contests...Brooklyn is batting .279 (83-298) over the last eight games.

**JUST KEEP K'ING:** Cyclones batters are currently leading the NYPL with 353 strikeouts this season in 1,280 team at-bats (27.6 %)...The Cyclones have 15 games this season with 10 or more strikeouts...OF **Michael Bernal** leads the New York-Penn League with 55 strikeouts and has only one game in July without a punchout.

**THE FROST OF JULY:** The Cyclones are 8-15 during the month of July and have been outscored 107-87 in the 23 games...Brooklyn has scored three runs or less in 12 of 23 contests during the month...Cyclones pitchers have allowed 188 hits in 197.2 innings over this span, with an additional 73 base runners by walk or hit-by-pitch.

**THE 500 CLUB:** The Cyclones are currently two games under .500...The team has never been more than seven games under .500 (0-7, in 2006)...Brooklyn is one of four pro franchises to finish .500 or better ever year since '01.

**JHO' DA MAN:** Cyclones 3B **Jhoan Ureña** currently has a 10 game hitting streak in which he is batting .341 (14-41)...Earlier this season, the 19-year-old had a 13-game hitting streak, which was the longest by a teenager in franchise history...Ureña is only the third player in franchise history to have two, 10-game hitting streak and only the second to do so in the same season, joining OF **Angel Pagan** who did it in 2001.

**UR' COMING HOME:** Cyclones 3B **Jhoan Ureña** has three straight multi-RBI games, and has eight RBI in his last five starts.

**MICHAEL THE MAGNIFICENT:** Cyclones OF **Michael Conforto** has hit safely in each of his six games since joining the team on July 19th...The 1st round selection is batting .583 (7-12) with the bases empty.

**TO 'ERR IS HUMAN:** The Cyclones currently rank last in the NYPL with a .962 fielding percentage...They have committed a league-high 57 errors.

**A RUN ON RUNS:** The Cyclones have scored six runs or more in six of their last eight games after having scored six times on only five occasions during the team's first 32 games of the season.

**LOOKING ROSEY:** Cyclones SS **Amed Rosario** has hit safely in nine straight contests, his longest streak of the season...The 18-year-old is batting .381 (16-42) over his current streak to raise his average from .260 to .298.

**HOME COOKIN':** The Cyclones have won four straight home games and have outscored their opponents 26-8 in these contests.
