ABOUT LAST NIGHT: The Cyclones had a season-high nine runs and 15 hits on Sunday night, as Brooklyn took the series opener from the Lowell Spinners by the score of 9-3...OF **Michael Bernal**, who was not in the starting lineup, went 4-for-4 with two doubles and four RBI to pace the offense...RHP **Marcos Molina** struggled early, but settled down and pitched 6.0 solid frames to collect the win.

VS. LOWELL: The Cyclones are 40-27 against the Spinners since 2001...Brooklyn went 3-2 against Lowell last season with one game being cancelled due to rain and never made up...Brooklyn went 1-1 at LeLacheur Park in 2013.

NOTES FROM LAST NIGHT: The Cyclones set new season-highs with nine runs scored and 15 hits during last night's contest...Brooklyn is the only team in the NYPL to not score double digit runs in a game this season...Brooklyn also had five doubles last night, a season-high.

THE FROST OF JULY: The Cyclones are 10-16 during the month of July but are 6-3 over their last nine games...The team has committed 39 errors in 26 games during the month.

THE 500 CLUB: The Cyclones are currently one game under .500...The team has never been more than seven games under .500 (0-7, in 2006)...Brooklyn is one of four pro franchises to finish .500 or better every year since '01

MOORE OF THAT: Cyclones C/2B **Tyler Moore** went 1-for-3 last night and has hit safely in three-straight games, tying a season-high...Moore had back-to-back multi-hit games on Friday and Saturday.

JHO' DA MAN: Cyclones 3B **Jhoan Ureña** currently has a 13-game hitting streak in which he is batting .321 (17-53)...Earlier this season, the 19-year-old had a 13-game hitting streak, which was the longest by a teenager in franchise history...Ureña is only the third player in franchise history to have two, hitting streaks of at least 10 games and only the second to do so in the same season, joining OF **Angel Pagan** who did it in 2001.

MICHAEL THE MAGNIFICENT: Cyclones OF **Michael Conforto** has hit safely in each of his nine games since joining the team on July 19th...He has five multi-hit games over this span...The nine game hitting streak to begin his pro career is the longest since 1B **Ike Davis** began the 2008 season with a 15-game hitting streak.

A RUN ON RUNS: The Cyclones have scored six runs or more in seven of their last 11 games after having scored six times on only five occasions during the team's first 32 games of the season.

LOOKING ROSEY: Cyclones SS **Amed Rosario** has hit safely in 10 straight contests, his longest streak of the season...The 18-year-old is batting .396 (18-47) over his current streak to raise his average from .260 to .299.

BERNING UP: Cyclones OF **Michael Bernal** had his second four-hit game of the season last night...He has four multi-hit games in his last 10 starts.

INURY UPDATE: Cyclones 1B **Michael Katz** suffered a right knee injury during last night's game...He will be reevaluated upon his return to New York but is expected to be placed on the Disabled List...OF **Joe Tuschak** is expected to be eligible to play this evening.
