IronBirds by the score of 3-2 on Friday night...Brooklyn's offensive struggles continued as they struck out 11 times...3B Jhoan Ureña went 3-for-4 with two doubles and an RBI to pace the Brooklyn bats...RHP Dillon Gee struck out 10 batters over 6.0 innings in his rehab start with the Cyclones.

VS. ABERDEEN: The Cyclones are 79-46 all-time against the IronBirds...Last year the Cyclones went 3-7 against Aberdeen, marking the first time in franchise history that the Cyclones lost the season series against the 'Birds... Prior to last season, the Cyclones were 23-7 against Aberdeen from 2010-2012...Brooklyn is 5-1 against the Birds so far this season

COUNTDOWN TO 1,000: The Cyclones currently have an all-time record of 590-404 in their 994 games played in franchise history...The team has a .594 winning percentage and is one of only four teams in affiliated baseball to not have a losing season since 2001.

UR-ON FIRE: Cyclones 3B Jhoan Ureña currently has an 12-game hitting streak...The 12 game streak is the longest active hitting streak in the NYPL this season, and only the third to reach double digits in the league...He is batting .333 (18-47) over this span with seven runs scored, and six RBI...He is only the second teenager to ever have a double-digit hitting streak with the Cyclones, joining OF Alhaji Turay who hit in 12 straight during the **2012** season.

SECOND TO NOTHING: Cyclones second basemen are occured with a RISP. batting .111 (7-63) this season.

ABOUT LAST NIGHT: The Cyclones fell to the Aberdeen MUCH ADO ABOUT NOTHING: Tonight the Cyclones will celebrate "Salute to Seinfeld Night" as the show celebrate's its 25th Anniversary...The team will wear puffy shirts during batting practice, there will be a pre-game Elaine Dancing Contest, and much much more...In addition, Larry Thomas - The Soup Nazi and Rosalind Allen. from the episode "The Marine Biologist" will be on hand to throw out first pitches...There will be five in game Seinfeld contests in addition to pre-game and post-game.
