ABOUT LAST NIGHT: The Cyclones fell to the Aberdeen IronBirds by the score of 18-2 on "Seinfeld Night" at MCU Park...The IronBirds jumped out to a 16-0 lead after the top of the fifth thanks, in part, to five Cyclones errors that led to seven unearned runs...Offensively, 1B **Jeff Diehl** went 3-for-4 with a run scored and RBI accounting for most of the Brooklyn offense...The game was played in front of a season-high crowd of 8,241.

VS. ABERDEEN: The Cyclones are 79-47 all-time against the IronBirds...Last year the Cyclones went 3-7 against Aberdeen, marking the first time in franchise history that the Cyclones lost the season series against the 'Birds... Prior to last season, the Cyclones were 23-7 against Aberdeen from 2010-2012...Brooklyn is 5-2 against the 'Birds so far this season

COUNTDOWN TO 1,000: The Cyclones currently have an all-time record of 590-405 in their 995 games played in franchise history...The team has a .594 winning percentage and is one of only four teams in affiliated baseball to not have a losing season since 2001.

JUST KEEP K'ING: Cyclones batters are currently leading the NYPL with 204 strikeouts this season through 20 games...Aberdeen ranks second in the league with 195 k's in 21 contests...For the Cyclones, 67 of these K's have occurred with a RISP.

BROO-KK-LYN: The Cyclones have 11 games this season with 10 or more strikeouts, including four of their last five games during the current losing streak...The team has 58 strikeouts total in 174 at-bats over their last five games.

DOUBLE TROUBLE: Prior to this season, the Cyclones had not allowed double digit runs since August 26, 2012, now they have allowed 11 or more runs in two of their last five games...Since the start of the 2010 season, the Cyclones have allowed double digit runs only four times... The 18 runs allowed were the most since the team allowed 21 runs on August 21, 2006 vs. Staten Island.

A NIGHT TO FORGET: Last night RHP **Casey Meisner** allowed nine runs in 3.1 innings on the mound...The nine runs allowed are the most ever by a Cyclones pitcher, topping the previous mark of eight runs allowed by RHP **Jeff Landing** on August 7, 2004 vs. New Jersey...The nine hits allowed by Mesiner rank as the third most allowed by a pitcher in franchise history behind **Luis Mateo** (8/02/12 at CT) and **Scott Shaw** (8/31/08 vs. HV).

KIND OF A BIG DIEHL: Cyclones 1B **Jeff Diehl** has hit safely in nine straight games dating to June 20th and is batting .353 (12-34) over this span.

THE DEFENSE RESTS: The Cyclones currently rank 12th in the NYPL with a .960 fielding percentage and have committed 31 errors in 20 games...The five errors committed by the Cyclones last night tied the franchise high, set several times, most recently on August 10, 2010 at Connecticut

RISP / REWARD: As a team, the Cyclones are batting .191 (35-183) with Runners in Scoring Position and .149 (13-87) with Runners in Scoring Position and two outs...The Cyclones have 67 strikeouts in 183 at-bats with runners in scoring position this season.
