ABOUT LAST NIGHT: The Cyclones and Renegades finished a marathon of four games in 22 hours with a split of a doubleheader at MCU Park on Tuesday afternoon... Brooklyn took Game One, by the score of 3-0, as RHP **Marcos Molina** and RHP **Josh Prevost** combined on a one hitter while OF **Michael Bernal** connected on his third home run of the season...In Game Two, Brooklyn managed only two hits as Hudson Valley returned the favor with a shutout of their own.

VS. STATE COLLEGE: The Cyclones are 18-6 all-time against the State College Spikes...Brooklyn is 10-2 in games played at MFLP and have outscored the Spikes 69-39 in these games...The Cyclones last played in University Park, PA in 2012, sweeping a three game set.

1,000 GAMES: The Cyclones played the 1,000th game in franchise history yesterday afternoon...After 1,000 games played, the team has a record of 593-407...The team has a .593 winning percentage and is one of only four teams in affiliated baseball to not have a losing season since 2001.

JUST KEEP K'ING: Cyclones batters are currently leading the NYPL with 240 strikeouts this season through 25 games...The Cyclones have 12 games this season with 10 or more strikeouts, including five of their last 10 games.

JUST LIKE JACKIE: In Game One of yesterday's doubleheader, OF **Tucker Sharp** stole home on the back end of a double steal...The feat has been accomplished several times in franchise history...**C Stacey Bennett** is the only Cyclone with a straight steal of home, on August 3, 2003, Jackie Robinson Day at MCU Park.

AT HOME ON THE ROAD: As a team, the Cyclones are batting .234 (81-346) in 10 road games...**SS Amed Rosario** is batting .324 (11-34) on the road and just .227 (10-44) at MCU Park...**3B Jhoan Ureña** is batting .371 (13-35) on the road and .278 (15-54) on the road.

THIS KATZ GOT CLAWS: Cyclones OF **Michael Katz** has hit safely in each of his last five games, including three multi-hit games...The 9th round selection from William & Mary has raised his batting average from .264 to .306 over this span.

THE "K" IN MIKE: Cyclones OF **Michael Bernal** leads the NYPL with 34 strikeouts...The 22-year-old has at least one strikeout in 21 of his 25 games this season, and has 12 strikeouts in 26 at-bats during the month of July.

THE DEFENSE RESTS: The Cyclones are currently 10th in the NYPL with a .962 fielding percentage and have committed 36 errors in 25 games...The Cyclones did not commit an error in either game of yesterday's doubleheader, marking only the second time this season that the team has had back-to-back errorless games (June 22 & June 23).

NOT SO HOT: Cyclones C **Tyler Moore** is 1-for-17 over his last five games...**2B Anthony Chavez** is hitless in his last 21 at-bats dating to June 18th, and has 13 strikeouts in these 21 AB's.

M-000000000-LINA: Cyclones RHP **Marcos Molina** extended his scoreless streak to 19.0 innings dating to June 15th...The 19-year-old leads the NYPL with a 0.38 ERA, ranks third in strikeouts and leads the league in WHIP and opponents batting average.
