ABOUT LAST NIGHT: The Cyclones fell to the Staten Island Yankees by the score of 7-2 in the finale of a four game set...The Cyclones committed four errors that led to four unearned runs, had two wild pitches, issued nine walks and struck out 11 times in what was a night to forget...RHP **Gaither Bumgardner** (0-1) was the hard luck loser after allowing four unearned runs over his 4.0 innings of relief...OF **Joe Tuschak** was the lone offensive bright spot, going 3-for-4 with a run scored.

VS. HUDSON VALLEY: The Cyclones are 68-48 all-time against the Hudson Valley Renegades...The Cyclones went 6-4 against the Renegades in 2013 and 7-3 in 2012 when Hudson Valley led the NYPL with a 52-24 record.

NEW SHERIFF IN TOWN: The 2014 season marks the first with **Tom Gamboa** as manager of the Brooklyn Cyclones...Gamboa is the 10th manager in franchise history and takes over for Rich Donnelly...Donnelly, who led the Cyclones from 2011-2013 is currently the third base coach for the Seattle Mariners and went 128-97 during his three seasons in Brooklyn.

YOUNG AND RESTLESS: The 2014 Cyclones roster features nine players under the age of 21 and four players who are still teenagers...On Opening Day, SS **Amed Rosario** was only 18 years, 6 months and 24 days old...The youngest player in franchise history is SS **Wilmer Flores** who suited up for the Cyclones in 2008 at just 17 years and 22 days old.

WALK ON THE WILD SIDE: The Cyclones currently lead the New York-Penn League with 26 walks issued on the season...The team has issued seven or more walks in three of four games this season.

JOE THREE-SCHAK: OF Joe Tuschak went 3-for-4 last night to pace the Brooklyn offense...It marked the fourth time in his 138 career games that he has collected three hits or more...Joe had two three hit games with the K-Mets last season, and a career-high four hits on July 4, 2013 with Kingsport at Johnson City.

K IT AIN'T SO: The Cyclones and Renegades rank first and second in the NYPL with 45 and 47 strikeouts on the season...Brooklyn struck out a franchise record 18 times in a nine-inning game during the first game of a double-header on Sunday at Staten Island.

RISP / REWARD: As a team, the Cyclones are batting .125 (5-40) with Runners in Scoring Position and .053 (1-19) with Runners in Scoring Position and two outs...OF **Joe Tuschak** is the only player on the team with multiple hits with RISP.

THE DEFENSE RESTS: The Cyclones have committed nine errors through four games, which have led to six unearned runs...Brooklyn led the league in fielding percentage in 2011 and 2012, while ranking second in the NYPL last year...The four errors committed last night are tied for the highest total since 2010 when the Cyclones had five fielding errors against Connecticut on 8/10/10.

FEELING A DRAFT: The Cyclones have six players on their Opening Day roster who were selected in the MLB Draft last week... RHP **Josh Prevost** (5th Round, Seton Hall), C **Tyler Moore** (6th Round, LSU), LHP **Brad Wieck** (7th Round, OK City University), OF **Michael Katz** (9th Round, William & Mary), LHP **Kelly Secrest** (10th Round, UNC-Wilmington).
