**ABOUT LAST NIGHT:** The Cyclones rallied in each of the last three innings as they came back to win 4-3 in extra innings at Dutchess Stadium on Wednesday night...3B **Jhoan Ureña** was the lone Cyclone with a multi-hit effort and his second hit - a solo blast in the top of the 9th - tied the game at 3-3 and pushed it into extra innings... SS **Amed Rosario** also connected on his first home run of the season, a solo shot, and C **Tyler Moore's** sac fly in the 10th provided the winning margin...LHP **Shane Bay** tossed a scoreless 10th for his first save of the year.

**VS. HUDSON VALLEY:** The Cyclones are 70-48 all-time against the Hudson Valley Renegades...The Cyclones went 6-4 against the Renegades in 2013 and 7-3 in 2012 when Hudson Valley led the NYPL with a 52-24 record.

**NEW SHERIFF IN TOWN:** The 2014 season marks the first with **Tom Gamboa** as manager of the Brooklyn Cyclones...Gamboa is the 10th manager in franchise history and takes over for Rich Donnelly...Donnelly, who led the Cyclones from 2011-2013 is currently the third base coach for the Seattle Mariners and went 128-97 during his three seasons in Brooklyn.

**YOUNG AND RESTLESS:** The 2014 Cyclones roster features nine players under the age of 21 and four players who are still teenagers...On Opening Day, SS **Amed Rosario** was only 18 years, 6 months and 24 days old... The youngest player in franchise history is SS **Wilmer Flores** who suited up for the Cyclones in 2008 at just 17 years and 22 days old.

**POWER PLAY:** After failing to hit a home run through the first four games of the season, the Cyclones have now hit three home runs in their last two games.

**WANNA BE STARTIN' SOMETHIN':** Through one turn in the rotation, Brooklyn starting pitchers have not allowed more than two runs in any of their starts... In 30.2 innings, Cyclones starters have allowed just five earned runs for a 1.47 ERA.

**NEW CHAK CITY:** OF **Joe Tuschak**, the Mets 6th round pick in 2011, has reached base safely in all six games this season...The Dillsburg, PA native leads the team in runs scored and hits.

**RISP / REWARD:** As a team, the Cyclones are batting .125 (7-56) with Runners in Scoring Position and .074 (2-27) with Runners in Scoring Position and two outs...Last night, OF / 1B **Michael Katz** had an RBI single in the top of the eighth that tied the score at 2-2...It was only the second hit by the Cyclones with RISP and two-out.

**THE DEFENSE RESTS:** The Cyclones have committed 13 errors through six games, which have led to six unearned runs...Brooklyn led the league in fielding percentage in 2011 and 2012, while ranking second in the NYPL last year.

**THIS KAT HAS CLAWS:** OF / 1B **Michael Katz** has hit safely in each of his four games with an at-bat to start his professional career...The 9th round selection from the College of William & Mary has five hits, three of which have gone for extra bases, to start his pro career

**UR-NOT GONNA BELIEVE THIS:** 3B **Jhoan Ureña** hit his first home run of the season to lead off the ninth inning last night...It was his first home run of the season, and his first since August 3, 2012 with the DSL Mets, a span of 229 at-bats.
