ABOUT LAST NIGHT: The Cyclones completed their three-game sweep of the Aberdeen IronBirds, taking the series finale 2-1 on Sunday afternoon...LHP **Carlos Valdez** and RHP **Gaither Bumgardner** combined to allow just one run on seven hits...Valdez (1-0) got the win and Bumgardner got the save thanks to 4.0 near-perfect innings of relief...Offensively, OF **Michael Bernal** hit a solo home run in the top of the fourth that provided the winning margin...OF **Tucker Tharp** added a three-hit effort and Brooklyn completed their trip a perfect 5-0.

VS. HUDSON VALLEY: The Cyclones are 71-48 all-time against the Hudson Valley Renegades...The Cyclones went 6-4 against the Renegades in 2013 and 7-3 in 2012 when Hudson Valley led the NYPL with a 52-24 record...This year, Brooklyn is 3-0 against the Renegades.

NEW SHERIFF IN TOWN: The 2014 season marks the first with **Tom Gamboa** as manager of the Brooklyn Cyclones...Gamboa is the 10th manager in franchise history and takes over for Rich Donnelly...Donnelly, who led the Cyclones from 2011-2013 is currently the third base coach for the Seattle Mariners and went 128-97 during his three seasons in Brooklyn.

WANNA BE STARTIN' SOMETHIN': Through 10 games, Brooklyn starting pitchers have more than two earned runs only once...In 53.2 innings, Cyclones starters have allowed just nine earned runs for a 1.51 ERA.

RISP / REWARD: As a team, the Cyclones are batting .172 (17-99) with Runners in Scoring Position and .128 (6-47) with Runners in Scoring Position and two outs....The Cyclones have 45 strikeouts in 99 at-bats with runners in scoring position this season.

BERN-ING UP: Brooklyn OF Michael Bernal is 7-for-13 (.538) over his last three games with three runs scored, a double, two triples, one home run, five RBI and two stolen bases...He has raised his batting average from .211 to .344 over this span.

THE DEFENSE RESTS: Last night marked the second time during the 2014 season that the Cyclones have not committed an error...The Cyclones have 17 errors through 10 games, which have led to 10 unearned runs...Brooklyn led the league in fielding percentage in 2011 and 2012, while ranking second in the NYPL last year.

TUCK-TERRIFIC: OF **Tucker Tharp**, who started his pro career 1-for-21 over his first six games is hitting .444 (8-18) over his last four starts...The former Kansas Jayhawk also has four stolen bases in six attempts over this stretch.

PITCHING IN: Cyclones hurlers have allowed just two runs, both earned, over their last 23.0 innings of work... Over this span they have scattered 12 hits, six walks and struck out 17 batters.

WE'RE GOING STREAKING: The Cyclones are currently riding a six-game winning streak...The six straight wins are tied for the longest winning streak since Brooklyn rattled off 10 straight wins during the 2009 campaign from June 28th - July 7th...The Cyclones started off the 2009 season with the best record in franchise history at 16-2.

THE K IN BROOKLYN: Cyclones batters are currently leading the NYPL with 103 strikeouts this season....Hudson Valley ranks second in the league with 96 K's...For the Cyclones 45 of these K's have occurred with a RISP.
