ABOUT LAST NIGHT: The Renegades ambushed Cyclones starter LHP **Alberto Baldonado** (0-1), scoring six runs on eight hits over 2.2 innings, to jump out to an early lead and never looked back...SS **Amed Rosario** went 3-for-4 and 3B **Jhoan Ureña** had a pair of hits, including a solo home run, two runs scored and two RBI to pace the Brooklyn offense....RHP **Brandon Welch** tossed 3.1 scoreless innings of relief and has tossed 9.0 shutout frames to start the season.

VS. ABERDEEN: The Cyclones are 77-45 all-time against the IronBirds...Last year the Cyclones went 3-7 against Aberdeen, marking the first time in franchise history that the Cyclones lost the season series against the 'Birds... Prior to last season, the Cyclones were 23-7 against Aberdeen from 2010-2012...Brooklyn swept a three-game series in Aberdeen last weekend.

COUNTDOWN TO 1,000: The Cyclones currently have an all-time record of 587-400 in their 987 games played in franchise history...The team has a .595 winning percentage and is one of only four teams in affiliated baseball to not have a losing season since 2001.

WANNA BE STARTIN' SOMETHIN': Through 12 games, Brooklyn starting pitchers have allowed more than two earned runs only twice...In 63.1 innings, Cyclones starters have allowed just 15 earned runs for a 2.13 ERA.

RISP / REWARD: As a team, the Cyclones are batting .185(20-108) with Runners in Scoring Position and .120 (6-50) with Runners in Scoring Position and two outs.... The Cyclones have 46 strikeouts in 108 at-bats with runners in scoring position this season.

UR-ON FIRE: Cyclones 3B **Jhoan Ureña** currently has a five-game hitting streak...The 19-year-old is batting .368 (7-19) over this span with three runs scored, and three RBI.

FAR FROM PURRRR-FACT: Brooklyn 1B **Michael Katz** has cooled down after his sizzling start to the season...The 9th round selection from William & Mary is 0-for-22 dating to his second at-bat on Friday, June 20th.

AMED, AMED: Cyclones SS **Amed Rosario** has strung together three straight multi-hit games and is batting .636 (7-11) over the stretch...Rosario leads the team with five multi-hit games in his 11 starts.

WE'VE BEEN ROBBED!: Last night the Hudson Valley Renegades stole six bases against the Cyclones...In 11 games prior to last night's contest, the Cyclones had allowed just four stolen bases...Brooklyn allowed a league-high 120 stolen bases during the 2013 season.

THE K IN BROOKLYN: Cyclones batters are currently leading the NYPL with 123 strikeouts this season....Aberdeen ranks second in the league with 118 k's...Nine different players on the Brooklyn roster have struck out 10 or more times...For the Cyclones 46 of these K's have occurred with a RISP.

THE FUTURE IS NOW: Former Cyclones catcher **Kevin Plawecki** was named to the roster of Team USA for the Future's Game to be played at Target Field in Minneapolis during the All-Star Game festivities...In addition, Plawecki was promoted to Las Vegas (AAA) of the Pacific Coast League after hitting .326 (73-224) with 18 doubles, six home runs and 43 RBI with the B-Mets.
