ABOUT LAST NIGHT: The Yankees jumped in front early, scoring five in the first inning and adding on four more runs in the third inning to take a commanding 9-1 lead and never looked back en route to a 11-5 victory on Saturday night at Staten Island...LHP **Carlos Valdez** (1-1) was tagged with the loss after allowing five runs, earned, on three hits with two walks in only 0.2 innings of work...OF **Michael Bernal** provided the lone offensive bright spot for Brooklyn with a three-run home run.

VS. STATEN ISLAND: The Cyclones hold an 90-84 advantage over Staten Island during the all-time series... Brooklyn went 6-8 against the Yankees in 2013, their first losing season against the Baby Bombers since 2006, when the team went 5-9 against Staten Island. The teams have split six games this season.

RISE AND SHINE: Cyclones pitcher had allowed 25 earned runs through their first 135.2 innings of work for a 1.66 team ERA...After last night's game in which the team allowed 11 runs, all earned, over 8.0 innings, the team ERA rose to 2.26.

DOUBLE TROUBLE: Last night marked the first time since August 26, 2012 at Staten Island that the Cyclones gave allowed double digit runs, and marked only the third time since the start of the 2010 season...Brooklyn allowed 12 runs on August 26, 2012 and gave up 13 runs on July 4, 2010 at Mahoning Valley.

COUNTDOWN TO 1,000: The Cyclones currently have an all-time record of 590-401 in their 991 games played in franchise history...The team has a .595 winning percentage and is one of only four teams in affiliated baseball to not have a losing season since 2001.

A GEE THING: RHP **Dillon Gee** will be making the start for the Cyclones this evening, marking the 19th time in franchise history that a Met has joined the Cyclones as part of a Major League Rehabilitation assignment... Gee, who began his professional career with the Cyclones in 2007, is the second player to play for the Cyclones as a minor leaguer and as a rehabbing major leaguer...OF **Angel Pagan** played with the Cyclones during the 2001 season and rejoined the team in 2008 while rehabbing.

UR-ON FIRE: Cyclones 3B **Jhoan Ureña** currently has a nine-game hitting streak...He is batting .333 (12-36) over this span with five runs scored, and four RBI...With a hit today, he would become only the second teenager to ever have a double-digit hitting streak with the Cyclones, joining OF **Alhaji Turay** who hit in 12 straight during the 2012 season.

RISP / REWARD: As a team, the Cyclones are batting .183 (28-153) with Runners in Scoring Position and .127 (9-71) with Runners in Scoring Position and two outs...The Cyclones have 60 strikeouts in 153 at-bats with runners in scoring position this season....Brooklyn went 3-for-16 with Runner in Scoring Position last night and left 10 men on base.

THE K IN BROOKLYN: Cyclones batters are currently leading the NYPL with 161 strikeouts this season....Aberdeen ranks second in the league with 152 k's...Ten different players on the Brooklyn roster have struck out 10 or more times...For the Cyclones 60 of these K's have occurred with a RISP.

SECOND TO NOTHING: Cyclones second basemen are batting .091 (4-44) this season.
