ABOUT LAST NIGHT: Brooklyn snapped their season-high five game losing streak with a 2-1 win over the Staten Island Yankees in 11 innings at Richmond County Bank Ballpark...2B **Vinny Siena** plated SS **Alfredo Reyes** with an RBI single in the top of the 11th which proved to be the game-winning run...LHP **Ruben Reyes** (1-0) got the win after tossing 2.0 perfect innings of relief.

VS. STATEN ISLAND: The Cyclones are 99-90 against the Baby Bombers all-time...Brooklyn is looking to collect their 100th win against the cross-bridge rival with a win tonight...It would mark the first time that Brooklyn has reached triple digits in wins against any NYPL franchise.

RECENT CYCLONES: Since July 20th, Brooklyn has gone 6-13, and scored three runs or less in 16 of 19 contests.

THE TRAGIC NUMBER: Since July 12th, if the Cyclones allow more than one run, the team is 3-17...Brooklyn is 9-18 overall during this stretch.

THE MAGIC NUMBER: The Cyclones are 14-2 when they score four or more runs in a game this season... Brooklyn has scored two runs or less 21 times this season and are 8-13 in these games...Brooklyn has scored one run or less on nine occasions.

NO HIT WONDERS: The Cyclones are currently last in the NYPL with a .218 team average, Aberdeen ranks 13th in the league at .231...Brooklyn ranks 158th out of 160 MiLB teams in batting, ahead of only the GCL Rays (.202) and GCL Astros (.201)...The last NYPL team to hit below .218 was Vermont (.215) in 2003...Brooklyn also ranks last in the NYPL with 339 hits, the Aberdeen IronBirds rank 13th with 377 base hits.

A RUN ON RUNS: The Cyclones have scored two runs or less in each of their last six games, a franchise record... The previous mark was five games from July 19 - July 23, 2012.

ONE RUN GAMES: Last night was Brooklyn's league-leading 22nd one-run game of the season...The team has gone 12-10 in these contests, including 3-2 against the Staten Island Yankees.

NOT SO GREAT IN MONTH #8: Since the calendar turned to August, Brooklyn has gone 2-7 and been outscored 50-18...The team is batting .210 (61-291) and has surrendered 15 unearned runs in these nine games.

ROAD TRIPPIN: Brooklyn is 4-11 over their last 15 road games and has been outscored 77-39 in these games.

RISP, NO REWARD: Brooklyn has gone 7-for-45 (.156) with runners in scoring position in their last nine games and are hitting .248 (90-363) with RISP this season... Since July 1st the team is batting .219 (61-278) with RISP after batting .341 (29-85) in June.

RUNNING AT WILL: Since July 21st, the Brooklyn Cyclones have allowed 38 stolen bases over the span of 19 games...Brooklyn ranks last in the league with a .218 caught stealing percentage (17-78)...The last 15 stolen bases attempts against the Cyclones have been successful dating to August 3rd.

KEEP ON K'ING: Brooklyn has struck out 70 times in their last seven games...The 'Clones have 404 k's on the year, second most in the league, behind only Lowell's 422 strikeouts.
